A John Roulston was in the shipping business in Scotland and sailed at intervals to Boston, MA.

Before 1676 he emigrated there and he and his descendants lived in Boston for almost a hundred years. Evidence in the Boston Archives, as well as the Boston Commons, shows their active life there. A number of them went to Pennsylvania and Virginia to land at Philadelphia and Jamestown.

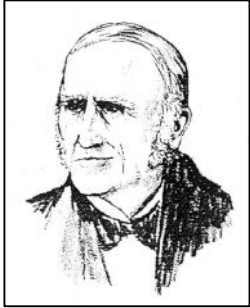

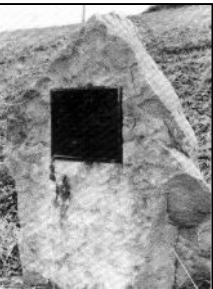

First tavern on the old Walton Road. This marker stands at the site of old Roulston Stand, later known as Mt. Richardson. Matthew Roulston settled here in 1795 and opened the first tavern on the old Walton Road. Presidents Andrew Jackson, James K. Polk, and Andrew Johnson were guest here.

James moved with his father in 1792 to Jefferson Co., TN. He moved after his marriage to the Chestnut Mound area, and operated, with his brother-in-law, Mark Young, (married his sister Ruth Raulston), an inn, called Raulston's Stand, a powder mill, a distillery and a large farm near the present Chestnut Mound, TN. In 1808 James Raulston & his family moved from Raulston's Stand to the Sequatchie Valley. He was also a land surveyor. In the War of 1812, he was a Colonel in command of the Third Regiment of Tennessee which was part of General William Carroll's Division in the Battle of New Orleans. He moved from the area to Marion Co., TN. His picture used to hang in the State Capital Bldg., Nashville, TN.
(I looked for the picture in October of 2001 and it was not there.)
James Raulston was the Sheriff of Jackson Co., TN in 1816.
Land Record – RG 50 Series 2 – Land Entry Books 55, 56, 57 & 58 – Reel 17 West Tennessee. Book 58 – pg. 63 - # 215 in the margin it reads "Survey Retd 10 Feb 1817 in name of W. Billingsley." and "I, James Raulston, sheriff of Jackson County do hereby transfer this entry No. 215 unto Walter Billingsley the same having been sold by James Cook, former sheriff of Jackson County to said Billingsley by Virtue of an execution Walter Billingsley vs John Anderson. 23 May 1816. J. Raulston Shff Jackson Co." James Raulston was not only a early settler, surveyor, financier, Colonel, but a friend of Andrew Jackson.

When Col. James Raulston first built this log cabin, since destroyed, he did not realize that the boundary survey of 1817 would find the house straddling the Tennessee-Alabama line. Raulston served both state legislatures, moving from one bedroom to another to establish "legal" residence in each state.

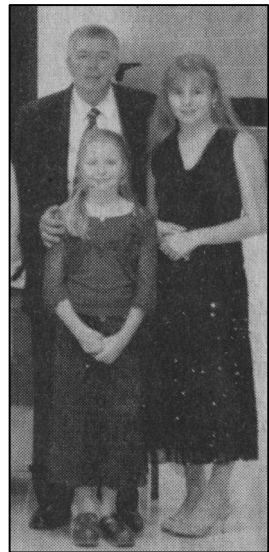

William Raulston, served as a member of the Colonial Militia. He was a private and served under the command of Colonel John Buchanan in 1758. Buchanan, Virginia, a city of some 1300, is now located in the county which obviously drew its name from the Buchanan family also of Scottish origin. This community furnished the fifteenth president of the United States. In 1789, the year the United States Constitution was ratified and the United States had its birth as a nation, Matthew Raulston sold his holdings in Botetourt County and within two years moved into what is now Tennessee. At that time its destiny as a state hung in the balance. Kegley's Virginia Frontiers, p.418

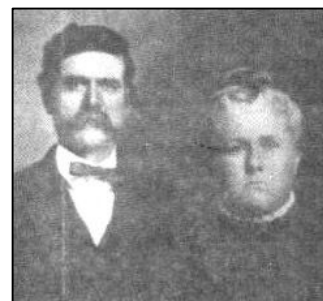

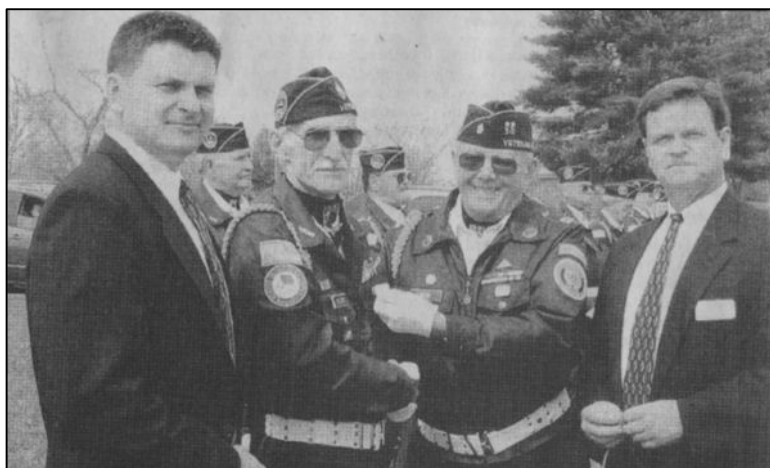
