Silas Francis Anderson, s/o Silas McCaleb Anderson said he could remember his grandmother, **Judith "Judy" Robinson Anderson**. He was about five years old when Judith, his grandmother died. He could remember her funeral. Judith lived with her son, Silas McCaleb Anderson in her last years and smoked a crock kiln pipe with a long stem, that she could reach into the fire place to light. He said that **Thomas Shirley Anderson**, his wife, Judith and her parents came by ox drawn wagons from Cumberland Co., VA to Roaring River near the Cumberland River, Jackson Co., TN. He believed that **Thomas Shirley Anderson** and **Judith Robinson** were married just before leaving Cumberland Co., VA.

Heirs: Paul Anderson – Francis M. Anderson (Jackson Co.), William T. Anderson (Jackson Co.), Thomas Anderson (Putnam Co.), Garland Anderson (Putnam Co.), Anna Bartlett, wife of Joshua Bartlett (Putnam Co.), Silas Anderson (Arkansas), Katherine Mahaney, wife of Ransom P. Mahaney (Jackson Co.), Edward Anderson, Fanny Reynolds – wife of John Warrick Reynolds.

Grandchildren: children of Edward – Anna Karr (Jackson), Vancil W. Anderson, adelaide Jones wife of Alfred Jones, Josephine Waller wife of Richard Waller, Thomas Anderson, Elizabeth Anderson, Jane Anderson, Cindarilla, wife of Edward was the guardian of above children.

Paul and Francis M. Anderson were appointed administrators of Thomas S.. Anderson's estate.

At the time of his death, Thomas Anderson possessed several tracts of land in Jackson County on Blackburn's fork of Roaring River. The deceased at the time of his death possessed of and had title to twelve Negroes, to wit, Issac, age about 56 yrs.; Jane, age about 48; Ailse about 37 yrs. old; Paul, about 13 yrs. old; Mundy, about about 9 yrs. old; Julia Ann, about 7 yrs. old; Pasty, about 5 yrs. old; Sarah, about 3 yrs. old; and Carr, about 2 ½ months old.

Being unable to divide his possessions equal they were sold at auction.

Title to the Negro boy, Bird (\$1,430) and Negro girl, Sarah (\$466) to Thomas Haile. (Joshua Haile his suriety).

Negro boy, Issac sold to Joshua Bartlett (\$700).

Negro woman, Vina sold to James R. Tolbert (\$1,300).

Negro girl, Jane sold to Henry Richmond (\$1,170).

Negro woman, Aalsey and her child, Carr sold to Ridley Draper (\$875).

Negro boy, Paul Thomas Anderson (\$360).

Negro woman named Jin (Jane) sold to Judith Anderson (\$600).

Negro girl named Patsy sold to William Darwin (\$600).

Negro girl named Julia Ann sold to J.W. Cruthers (605).

Negro boy named Mundy (\$1,050).

Paul Anderson purchased land for the sum of \$1,500.00.

Sale held the 2nd day of April, 1859.

Thomas Anderson gave each child as they married \$10.00 to start housekeeping and a cow and calf valued at \$10.00 . Some he gave a Negro which were valued at \$900.00 of which was charged to their part in the dividing of the inheritance.

Thomas Shirley Anderson

Thomas Shirley Anderson, Sr. (b. February 8, 1779; d. October 8, 1858); settled on Blackburn's Fork in Jackson County, Tennessee as early as 1806. He was the second of fourteen (14) children born to William (1753-1805) and Catherine Shirley Anderson (1753-1805) in Cumberland County, Virginia. In 1807, Thomas married Judith (Judy) Robinson (b. May 9, 1785; d. November 5, 1868) the daughter of Edward Robinson, Jr. and Annah Meador Robinson.

Traveling with Thomas were his brother, Joel Anderson (1781-1852) and Garland Anderson (1783-1850), also, many members of the Robinson family, including the parents of Judith Anderson. Their means of transportation was by wagons drawn by oxen. As they traveled through the Cumberland Mountains, Annah Robinson gave birth to a son. No name would be more proper for this son than Cumberland Robinson.

The Spring Creek Baptist Church received by experience, Thomas Anderson, the first Saturday of September, 1813. Many members of the family became a part of the Spring Creek Baptist Church, including Annah (Anny) Robinson.

Thomas Shirley Anderson received grants for land and at his death, owned 1200 acres of land, approximately 400 acres on the east side and 800 acres on the west side of Blackburn's Fork Creek. Their house and barn and other out-houses were built of logs. The house stood beside a spring along side the creek, while the barn and other out-houses were located where the Whitson Smith house presently stands. Some of the log out-houses were standing in the 1950's. The Old Anderson Cemetery is about 200 yards from the Creek, on the east side, located on a bank overlooking the grounds of the home site. Thomas Shirley and Judith Anderson are buried there, along with many family members. Following the death of her husband, Judith Anderson spent her last days with her son, Silas McCaleb Anderson, near Silver Point, Tennessee.

Their children were: William James, "Short Billy" (1808-1890) married 1st Polly Lynn, married 2nd Martha Wallis, married 3rd Judy Gibson. Garland "Gallant" (1810-1868) married Sarah Jones. Edward "Ned" (1811-1855) married Lucinda Mahaney. Frances "Fannie" (1812-?) married John Warrick Reynolds. Catherine "Katie" (1814-?) married Ranson P. Mahaney. Ann "Annie" (1816-1892) married Joshua Bartlett. Thomas Shirley, Jr. (1818-1861) married Lousia Alexander. Paul Thomas (1821-1866) married Susie Johnson. Silas Caleb (1823-1889) married Jane Wilson. Francis Marion (1825-1903) married Frances Almeda Ritchie.

As the children married, their father gave each child \$10.00 to start housekeeping and a cow and calf valued at \$10.00. Ned, Annie and Thomas Jr. moved to Buffalo Valley to buy land for 35 cents an acre as early as 1838. Silas McCaleb "Caleb" Anderson later went to Silver Point and Fannie died in MO, William "Short Billy", Catherine, Paul, & Francis remained in Jackson Co., TN. In later life, Francis went to DeKalb Co., TN where he died.

Anna Karr has married Andrew T. Anderson. Anna Anderson, Thomas Anderson Jr., Vancil W. Anderson, Adelaide Jones, Josephine Waller, Elizabeth Anderson and Jane Anderson are grand children of Thomas Anderson, deceased, being children of his deceased son, Edward Anderson. The

Reynolds' and Louisa Clark are also grand children and the children of his deceased daughter, Fanny Reynolds. All others named as heirs-at-law are his children. Paul Anderson, Francis Marion Anderson are the administrators. The widow, Judith Anderson, is entitled to dower. (Ibid 200-2). Thomas Anderson had made advancements in his lifetime to his sons, Thomas, William, Paul, Silas, Edward, Garland, and Francis Marion Anderson, and to his daughters, Anna Bartlett, Katherine Mahaney and Fanny Reynolds. He made a bequest to the illegitimate child of his son, Silas Anderson. His widow, Judith, dissented from the will. (Ibid 373)

Shirley Anderson** and said **Smiths** to **Lion Johnson** in the 10th District and the elections to be held at **John Terrys**.

Stephen Robinson had grown children when he came to Smith fork in 1798, so his own family made a large group. **Stephen's brother Edward, Jr.** settled in Jackson County, Tennessee, and **Edward's grandsons Francis and Silas Anderson** located on the Caney Fork around Mine Lick about the time of the Civil War. Stephen Robinson's brother Field also came to Tennessee. Field's son Alexander Robinson lived near Dowelltown, and his descendants have intermarried with Stephen Robinson's descendants.²²

Stephen Robinson's wife was **Betty Holland**; her sister **Mary married Nataniel Corley**. The Corleys moved to Tennessee, and in 1815 Nathaniel bought 445 acres on Smith Fork about three miles from the Robinson home.²³ He built his home on a hill overlooking the creek, one of the most beautiful locations in DeKalb County or in Middle Tennessee. The original home and farm are still owned by the Corley family.

Look to your right when you cross the bridge close to the Overton Cemetery and the Asa Lynn Cemetery is at the far end of the field. Crops are grown next to the cemetery but the cemetery is in a patch of woods that is about 50 feet from the road. Mr. Will Terry Johnson told Suzanna Mitchell and myself that his great grandmother was buried there along with many others besides Asa Lynn Sr. When you cross over Roaring River, here you will bear to the right toward the “Dirt” Cave. (A copy of the deed, spelling is as listed in copy. Original deed is held by Harold Hawkins of Cookeville, TN. Asa is reputed to be buried across the river from the Overton Cemetery, where a lot of Lynn’s are buried, out in the middle of the field. Harold Hawkins took us to the field, but the outline of the grave had disappeared. When he owned the property, he told us the grave was outlined with Cedar stakes at the four corners). A lot is still unknown about the life of Asa Lynn. What follows is what we know to this date. There is some confusion as to his date of birth. Some say ca. 1777, as born out by the 1850 census. The other proof is from a claim filed by his 2nd wife Mary Lynn. In 1883 she filed a Claim of Widow for Service Pension for service in the War of 1812, with W.M. Gailbreath, in Gainesboro, Jackson Co., TN. She describes him as being six feet tall, 175 lbs., has black hair, fair skin. We couldn’t read (the color of his eyes), and that he was born in South Carolina in 1783. (In the 1850 census, he said he was born in North Carolina) she further states that before marriage her name was Mary Regan, and that she had not been married before. They were married by Justice of the Peace, Marron Dixon, in September 1845. Asa’s first wife Elizabeth Hawkins having died in March 1844. Elizabeth was the daughter of Joseph Hawkins, a Veteran of the Revolutionary War, who had a farm adjoining Asa Lynn on Spring Creek, a tributary of Roaring River. Asa had a farm consisting of 304 acres on Spring Creek in Jackson County, TN. It was near the Community of Marengo, in Jackson County. Marengo no longer exists, but was near Asa’s farm. We visited the farm in the fall of 1993, courtesy of Harold Hawkins, of Cookeville, TN. In the early days the Morgans, Loftis, Hawkins, Johnsons, Lees, and Lynns seemed to dominate the Spring Creek area.

Asa was drafted in Gainesboro, TN 26 January 1814. He served as a Private in Captain Bennett’s Company, 4th Regiment of the Tennessee Militia. He was granted a pension in 1834 for life at \$33.33 per annum. The spelling of his man in a Land Deed to Archibald Loftis on 15 July 1854, was Lynn and later in the deed as Linn. We can assume the first to be correct, because all his Tennessee descendants have all used that form to this date. His lineage is believed to be Scot/Irish.

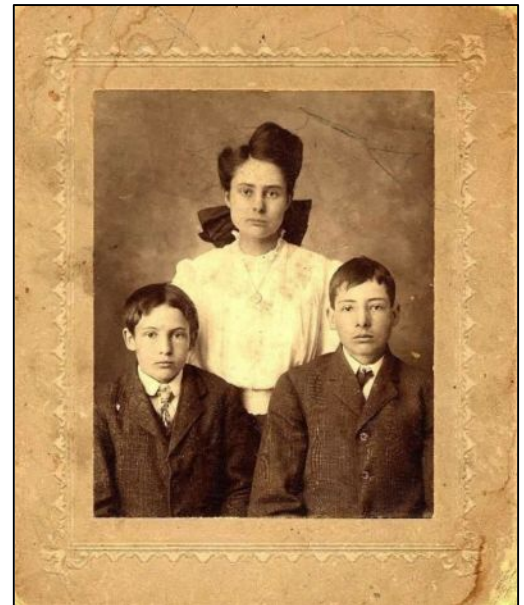

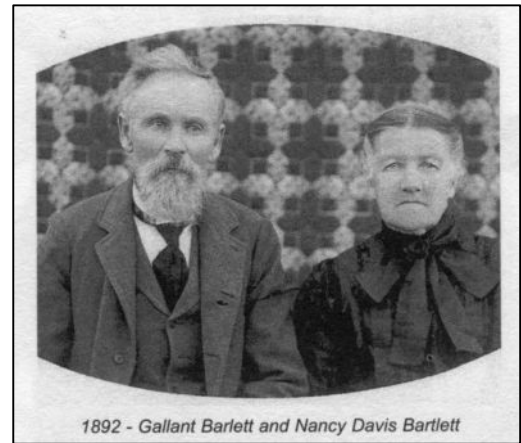
