

**SARAH ANN BIRDWELL JACKSON Obit:**

Age 84, one of the most beloved and widely known citizens of Jackson County, died at her daughter's, Mrs. Sidney Fox's home, Mon. at 7 o'clock, A.M., Jan 23. Funeral was conducted by Rev. John W. Fox at the Byers Cemetery Wed., at 1 o'clock, Jan 25.



She is survived by her children and one brother, Thomas E Birdwell and one sister, Mrs. Thomas Edward Anderson.

She was the mother of twelve children, 10 of whom survive: Mrs. W(m.) C Aytes, who lives in Tex.; Mr. J. F. Jackson, deceased; Mrs. Sidney (Columbus) Fox, Rt. 3; Mr. Thomas Benton Jackson of Putnam Co.; Mrs. Lucy Harley, deceased; Mr. Hazy Jackson of Sumner County; Mrs. Fate Stout of Jackson County; Mrs. Ida Harley of Oklahoma; Mrs. Henry Chaffin of Sumner Co.; Mr. Bratch Jackson of Sumner Co.; Mr. John K. **Martha Ardehlia "Delia" (Jackson) Chaffin Obit.**

b. 14 June 1875 – d. 24 September 1956, Cottontown, TN, md on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of December 1895, Jackson Co., TN to **William Henry Chaffin**, b. 20 June 1877 – d. 21 November 1952.. Delia (Jackson) Chaffin, d/o **John Stanley Jackson & Sarah Ann Birdwell**. William Henry & Delia (Jackson) Chaffin are both buried in the White House Church of Christ Cemetery, Sumner Co., TN.

Delia Jackson Chaffin died Sept. 24<sup>th</sup>, following a long illness at the home of her son, Carols Chaffin at Cottontown, TN, Route 1. She was 81 years, 3 months old. She was the daughter of the late John Stanley and Sarah Ann Birdwell Jackson and the widow of Henry Chaffin, who preceded her in death November 21, 1952. She was a member of the Church of Christ. Survivors include one son, Charles Chaffin, Cottontown; one daughter, Mrs. Elue Gee of Des Monies, IA; 11 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren and a large number of nephews. Pallbearers will be her nephews: Burton Fox, Herman, Kaier, Armel Lee, and Freeman Jackson, and Luther Short. Funeral services were held at Whitehouse Church of Christ, with burial in the church cemetery.
