Isaac Columbus Flatt died at his home April 25, 1940. He had been in feeble health for several years. He was born in 1854, making his stay on earth 86 years.

He was married to Miss Mary Frances Denton in 1872 and to this union were born twelve children, ten boys and two girls.

He is survived by 8 sons and 2 daughters as follows: Mrs. Howard Ragland, Henry P., James W. and J. D. Flatt, of Gainesboro Route 3, Taylor W., George C. and Walter C. Flatt of Bloomington Springs Route 1, Frank Flatt and Mrs. Jeff Fox, of Nashville, and Wesley P. Flatt of Cookeville. He was preceded in death by his wife in 1926 and two sons, John B. Flatt in 1919, and William Flatt in 1920. He is also survived by 57 grandchildren and 90 great-grandchildren and one great great grandchild. Also two sisters, Mrs. Marsh Brown of Nameless and Mrs. Charlie Lock of Gainesboro Route 3, and several nieces and nephews.

He obeyed the Gospel and was baptized into the Church of Christ in early life.

Funeral services was conducted by Bro. John W. Fox and his body laid to rest in the family graveyard on Flynn's Creek. The large crowd that attended his burial and the beautiful flowers showed the love and high esteem in which he was held.
