*Cemetery notes and/or description: Located in Buffalo Valley on the old Alcorn farm; also owned by Houston Hayes and wife; now by the Brad Tucker family. It is located about half way up the hill at the back of the house. This was once a very large cemetery, only one rock remains and it is broken off its foundation. (The photo is a cenotaph for the Bartlett-Alcorn cemetery which is located up a hill behind the farm on Alcorn Cemetery Road, Buffalo Valley. It has been all but destroyed, with only one fieldstone remaining, and access is difficult at best. This cenotaph is located at the Alcorn Family Cemetery behind the barn at the first house on Alcorn Cemetery Road).

(James Lee Alcorn, b. 3 May 1802, NC – d. 23 September 1855, TN, md Elizabeth Martha Johnson, b. January 1805, NC). James Lee Alcorn, s/o James L. Alcorn (1758-1825) and Diannah McDaniel Woodard (1774-1830)

Whoever made the marker has inaccurate information on it as he died sometime after the 1860 census as did his wife who was a Blackburn not a Johnson. census records of 1860 and 1870 show this couple alive with James doing work as a blacksmith.

(1850 census, South Division, Smith Co., TN: Dwl: 616 - James Allcorn is head of household, 48 yrs. old, NC, (Occupation: Blacksmith), md to Elizabeth, 45 yrs. old, NC. Children: Robert, 25 yrs. old, (Occupation: Blacksmith); Nancy, 22 yrs. old; William, 20 yrs. old; Jane, 16 yrs. old; Rebecca, 13 yrs. old; James 10 yrs. old & Mary Allcorn, 5 yrs. old. All born in NC).

(1860 census 9th Civil Dist., Putnam Co., TN: Dwl: 985 – James Alcorn is head of household, 59 yrs. old, SC, (Occupation: Blacksmith), md to Elizabeth, 57 yrs. old, TN. Children: James H., 18 yrs. old, TN & Mary A. Alcorn, 12 yrs. old, TN).

(1870 census 9th Civil Dist., Putnam Co., TN: Dwl: 18 – **James Alcorn** is head of household, 68 yrs. old, SC, (Occupation: Blacksmith), md to **Elizabeth**, 65 yrs. old, TN).

Daniel Morgan Bartlett is buried in the Daniel Bartlett Graveyard, Putnam Co., TN along with his 2nd wife **Nancy Ann (Maynard) Bartlett** (1855-1937).
