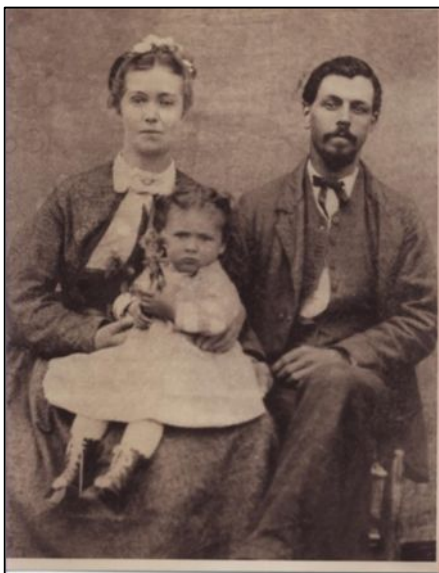

John A. Countiss Died Tuesday Night:



Esq. John A. Countiss died Tuesday night after an illness of several months at his home about three miles Northwest of this city. He was about seventy years old and was one of Putnam county's best known and most highly respected citizens. He was a man of the strictest integrity and enjoyed the esteem of all who knew him. For a number of years he was a member of the County Court and he served for twenty-five years as a public school director of the First district.

He is survived by his wife and several grown children and a large number of grandchildren. He was native of Virginia and came to Putnam county in his young manhood.

He was a devoted member of the Cumberland Presbyterian church, and for many years had been a member of Mount View Lodge, No. 179, I. O. O. F. of this city.
