\***Note**: Jonathan Lasley Ensor, 82, highly respected farmer and citizen of the 16th district, died at his home near Baxter Friday after having been in failing health for several months.

Funeral services were conducted at the home by Rev J A Harris Saturday afternoon, after which his remains were laid to rest in the Allison cemetery where the Masons had charge of the service.

Besides his wife he is survived by seven boys; Rev. D. A. Ensor of Cookeville; Rev. S. M. of Springfield; Rev. J. O. of Murray KY; S. W. of Detroit; R. L., Charlie and J. B. of Baxter and seven daughters; Mrs. V. C. Allison of Cookeville; Mrs. R. B. Gentry of Lawson, OK; Mrs. O. P. Gentry of Smyrna, TN; Mrs. Oliver Maxwell, Mrs. Birch Gentry, Misses Ida and Martha Ensor, all of Baxter.

Mr. Ensor served from 1894 to 1898 as County Court Clerk of this county.

He was converted and joined the Methodist church at the age of 17.

Hon. Josiah Jared, one of the most prominent and popular citizens of Putnam County died last Wednesday night (15 September 1898) at his home in Rock Springs Valley. He grew to manhood in this county. After completing his education he was a successful teacher, but for many years he devoted his attention to management of his large farm. All his life he was a great student and reader. In 1831 he joined the Methodist Church and for sixty-eight years he lived a Christian life full of good deeds and noble virtues. In 1851 he married Frances Bennett, whom he survived for several years. Burial took place near his home at Low Gap Cemetery, TN.

JARED, JOSIAH: Hon. Josiah Jared Dead. -- Hon. Josiah Jared of Rock Spring, died at his home last Friday, at the advanced age of eighty three years. Mr. Jared was one of the oldest inhabitants of Putnam county, having been born on its soil before the county was established, where he has always lived and been one of our most honored and useful citizens. He was a man of broad intellect, and great depth of thought, and was a tower of strength to the community in which he lived. He was formerly a school teacher, but later turned his entire attention to agricultural pursuits, in which he accumulated a comfortable fortune, having laid by a sufficient store to make his declining years comfortable. He was the head of a prominent family -- his sons who survive him are all prominent in this county, and his daughters possessed much culture and refinement. Mr. Jared was a strict Jeffersonian Democrat, and rendered much service to the success of his party. He was buried in the family burial ground near his home.
