Leonard Murphy, who was standing in the door with Mahan, was knocked senseless by the bolt and was slightly injured. Boards were knocked from the house, and other slight damage occurred.

Mahan was a farmer, the son of P H Mahan of Ensor, and was married.

Funeral services were conducted last Saturday afternoon at the home, with burial at the family cemetery.
