

## OLD HOLLADAY CEMETERY

Putnam Co., TN

Located across the road and creek west of Rock Springs Church on the hill top. The markers are down, weather beaten and in poor condition. There are many graves marked only with native lime stones. Only one marker remains standing along side a cedar.

Located across the road from the Rock Springs Church on Medley-Amonette Road in Buffalo Valley. There were a few headstones still existing on the hilltop, but most have been lost.
