Bradley Maddux, one of the good citizens of the Rock Springs Valley community, near the Smith and Putnam county line, died at his home on December 6 after an illness of many years.

Mr. Maddux was 75 years of age and was one of the Upper Cumberland section's most successful farmers. He numbered his friends by the score. He was one of the leading members of the Methodist church for years and years, and was a good an influential citizen.

He was married in Carthage 40 years ago, his bride being Miss Mary McClarin, a sister of Mayor C. R. McClain. Besides his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Clemmie McKinley and one step-son, Joe Maddux.

The funeral services were conducted at the Rock Springs church on December 7 by his old friend and former pastor, Rev. J. L. Smotherman, and burial was made in the family lot.

Mr. Maddux was known for him numerous deeds of charity. He was successful in business and was always found willing to aid and assist others. He will be greatly missed in his community.

Mrs. Maddux, 73 years of age, was the widow of the late Bradley Maddux, who was one of the prominent farmers and citizen's of the Buffalo Valley section of Putnam County. She removed to Cookeville to make her home a few years ago. Mrs. Maddux was born and reared in Carthage, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jimmie McClarin and was a sister of the late Chas. R. McClarin. She is survived by 2 children, Mrs. Clemmie McKinley of Cookeville and Joe Maddux of Buffalo Valley, 1 grandchild, Robert McKinley of Carthage, TN.

**Tennessee Melinda Maddux** married **Thomas Calhoun**, son of **Matthew Cowan McKinley**, grandson of **Robert McKinley** and **Salley Cowan**, who was born in North Carolina and fought in the Revolutionary war. **Tennessee Melinda Maddux's** sister **Sara Francis** was also married to **Thomas Calhoun's McKinley's** half-brother **James Donald McKinley**. I have been trying to find all the descendents of **Robert McKinley's** four children: **Elizabeth** who married **Richard Moore**, **James F.** who married **Eliza Bates**, **Matthew Cowan** who was married to (1) **Jane Newton Saddler**, (2) **Martha Woodrum** (mother to my great grandfather) (3) **Darthula McDonald**, and **Josiah Alexander** who moved to Missouri and then to California in 1853 (I live in Northern California near Sacramento).

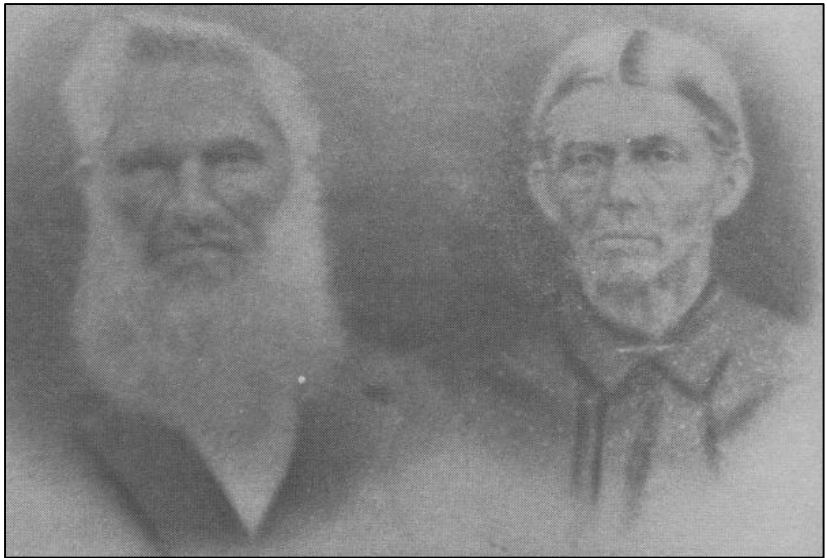
