TRIBUTE FOR JOSEPH C. "JOE" PIPPIN: Pippin, Joe: IN MEMORY. -- A Tribute to the Memory of Joe Pippin by his Teacher. -- Joe had just arrived at his majority being 21 a few days before his death. He was a member of the Christian church, a very exemplary young man. He had been a student in our school for several years past. He was a hard worker and could keep up a full line of different studies. I found him a model student, a good young man being well advanced in his studies. It seemed that he had a fine future before him He was a favorite with the entire school, I never had occasion to correct him during all of our association as teacher and pupil. His father tells me that Joe never spoke and (sic) unkind word to him or his mother. He died of Typhoid fever, living only one week after his attack.
