

Deed – Josiah Bartlett and Mary Bartlett to Robert Filmore Maxwell

State of Tennessee – Filed for Putnam County probate on this 9 day of August 1907 at 3:15 PM and noted in Filation Book “B” on page 266 and recorded in Book 2 on page 61, SF. Carr Register

Know all men by these presents that we Josiah Bartlett and wife Mary Bartlett for the consideration of Four Hundred dollars have this day bargained and sold and do hereby transfer and convey unto R.F. Maxwell his heirs and assigns forever a certain price or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of Tennessee County of Putnam and Civil District No. 11. On the waters of the middle fork of Indian Creek of Caney Fork containing by survey nine acres and twenty poles be the same more or less and bounded as follow to wit: Beginning at a stone standing in said R.F. Maxwell east boundary line running thence south 75 degrees east twenty nine poles to a small cedar tree thence north 45 degrees east twenty three poles to a hackberry above a spring. Thence north 17 degrees west six poles to a sycamore on the bank of the creek. Thence north 25 degrees west down said creek with the middle of the same thirty poles to a stake in the creek, thence north 77 degrees west fourteen poles to a stake in said creek. Thence south 73 degrees west about seven or eight feet south of the creek bluff fifteen poles to a stake in the said R. F. Maxwell’s east boundary line thence south with said east boundary line thirty nine poles to the beginning.

To have and to hold the above described land to the said R.F. Maxwell and his heirs and assigns forever. We do covenant and bind ourselves our heirs and representatives to warrant and forever defend the title to said land and every part thereof against the lawful claims of all person whomsoever. In testimony whereof we have hereunto set out hands and seals this 11th day of April 1894.
