

## Memory Book of Virgil Timothy Denny



Virgil Timothy Denny was born November 17th, 1884 at home on the family farm in Buffalo Valley, Civil District 11, Putnam County, TN. Virgil purchased land not far from his parents, Timothy Denny and Hettie Paul. Virgil had one sister named Minnie Mytle Denny. Virgil developed a farm on his land and this is where he died on June 26, 1949, by a self-inflicted gun shot wound at the age of 64. He had been quite ill with stomach cancer, the pain must have made him desperate and depressed.

His funeral was held at Carver Funeral Home, Cookeville, TN on June 28, 1949 at 2:00 in the afternoon. Officiating Clergymen were: Rev. Angel, Rev. Thornton Fowler and W.W. Jared. The organist was Mrs. Jeff Wall and she played "What a friend we have in Jesus," "Amazing Grace," and "When the mists have rolled away."
