The wedding was solemnized July 16 in Angola, IN. The bride wore a white street length spring suit with navy blue accessories. Her flowers were orchids.

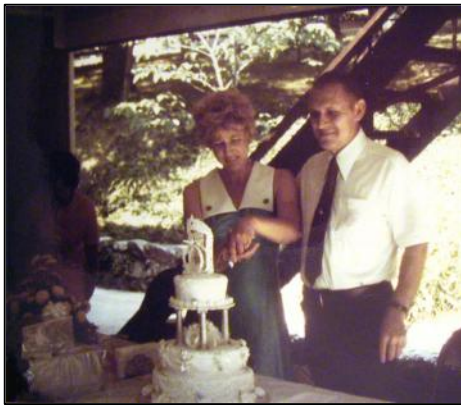
The bride formerly of Sparta attended White County High School and was employed in Detroit.
