COOKEVILLE -- Memorial services for Nancy Sharpe Woods, 65, will be held at 4 p.m. on Wed., April 17, from the chapel of Hooper & Huddleston Funeral Home.

The family will receive friends from 4-7 p.m. on Tues., April 16, at the funeral home.

Mrs. Woods died on Thurs., March 22, 2001, at Masters Health Care in Algood.

Bassett of Cookeville; a niece, Rebecca J. Bassett of Cookeville; six cousins of Cookeville; and a grand-niece of Hermitage.
