

WILLIAM "WILL" BRADLEY ALCORN OBT.

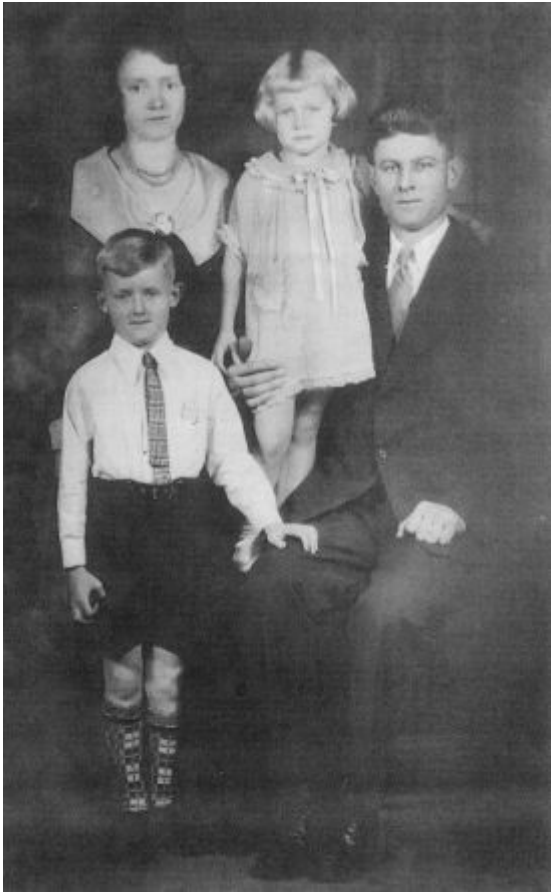
