This information is to show the families of Denny and Prichard and the relationship between the two. Benjamin "Ben" Prichard was the son of Sidney Pritchett/Prichard & Martha Robinson. Sidney Prichard and Martha Robinson were married 10 November 1870 in DeKalb Co., TN. Issue from this union was Sophrana & Benjamin "Ben" Prichard maybe others. Benjamin Pritchett married on the 6th of February 1838 in Orange Co., NC to Elvira Brown, they are the parents of Sidney Pritchett/Prichard.

(North Carolina, Marriages 1759-1979: GS Film #6330316, Benjamin Pritchett md 6 February 1839, NV to Elvira Brown).

(Tennessee State Marriages, 1780-2002: DeKalb Co., TN, pg. 108, #114 - Sidney Prichard married 10 November 1870, DeKalb Co., TN to Martha Robinson). (Sidney Prichard & Martha Robinson Marriage License issued Nov 7 1870. I solemnized the rites of matrimony between the above names on the 10th day of November 1870. F. H. Smith Justice of the Peace for DeKalb County Tennessee).

In the 1840 census of Wilson Co., TN we see that Ben Pritchett is head of household married to Elvira (Brown) Pritchett.

In the 1850 census of Dist. 13, Jackson Co., TN we see that Sidney Pritchett/Prichard is 7 years old living with his parents Benjamin & Elvira Pritchett/Prichard.

In the 1860 census of Dist. 11, Putnam Co., TN we see that Sidney Pritchett/Prichard is 17 years old living with his mother Elvira Prichard, 43 years old.

In the 1870 Sidney Prichard is 26 years old, born in NC in living in the 9th Civil Dist. of Putnam Co., TN, Dwelling 19/Household 19. Living with him is his mother Elvira Prichard, 52 years old.

In the 1880 census I have not yet found Sidney Pritchett/Prichard. His mother Elvira now 63 years old is born in South Carolina, living with her son Stephen Prichard and James R. Prichard age 20 and Eliza Ola Prichard age 16, both born in Tennessee.

In the 1880 census 9th Civil Dist. of Putnam Co., TN you find the family of James Mills Denny, s/o Zachariah Denny & Katherine Stallings. James Mills Denny is 62 years old and is married to Martha Robinson who is 29 years old. They had two children Martha A. Denny, 2 years old and James W. Denny, 9 months old. James Mills Denny had two step children living in this household which would have been the children of Sidney Prichard and Martha Robinson. Sophrana Prichard is 9 years old and Benjamin Prichard is 7 years old.

James Mills Denny - b. 14 March 1819, Smith Co., TN - d. before 1900. James married md 1st 2 July 1846, Martha A. Scuddert – b. 31 May 1825 - d. 8 October 1875 - md 2nd ca. 1877, Martha Robinson b. July 1850, TN -d. 4 April 1919 – Wallace Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN - d/o Mack & Martha Robinson.

The children of James Mills Denny and his 1st wife Martha A. Scuddert were: Mary Louiza “Lucy” Denny married 15 November 1866 to Simon Henry Maxwell; Amanda “Manda” “Sissy” Catherine Denny married 1 February 1874 Simon Henry Maxwell after her sister’s death.

The children of Sidney Pritchett/Prichard & Martha Robinson were: Sophrana “Frony” Denny - b. December 1871, TN md a Mr. McGuffey and Benjamin “Ben” McMillan Denny – b. 29 March 1872, TN - d. 14 September 1939 - md Adelaide Fisher- b. 21 December 1874, TN- d. 3 November 1944, d/o Logan Fisher & Martha Granton. (Adaline (Fisher) Denny: DC # 28428, Putnam Co., TN).

(Tennessee State Marriages, 1780-2002: DeKalb Co., TN, pg. 108, #114 - Sidney Prichard married 10 November 1870, DeKalb Co., TN to Martha Robinson). (Sidney Prichard & Martha Robinson Marriage License issued Nov 7 1870. I solemnized the rites of matrimony between the above names on the 10th day of November 1870. F. H. Smith Justice of the Peace for DeKalb County Tennessee).

In the 1900 census Civil Dist. 9, Putnam Co., TN, Martha (Robinson) Denny is head of household July 1850 – 49 years old a widow (5 children born 5 children living). Martha Denny was b. July 1850, TN and d. 4 April 1919. She is buried in the Wallace Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN, d/o Mack & Martha Robinson. *Source: Putnam Co., TN - Vitals - Death Records Transcription (1919)* Living in the household are her children, Martha A., James W. & Festus E. Denny. Also living in the household is Sophrana “Frony” Prichard McGuffey 28 years old a widow (6 children born, 5 children living) and her children Martha C., James Arthur, Willey, Lilly & Lewis E. McGuffey.

According to the 1900 census of the 8th Civil District of DeKalb Co., TN, Benjamin “Ben” McMillan Prichard born March 1875, 25 years old is head of household married 6 years to Adelaide “Adalade” Fisher- b. 21 December 1874, TN - d. 3 November 1944. Living in the household are their children, Larner, Brusten “Bruce” and Amanda Prichard. *Note: Ben listed as 7 years old in the 1880 census.*

In the 1910 census Benjamin “Ben” McMillan Prichard. 33 years old is head of household married 15 years to Adelaid, 32 years old, (7 children born, 5 children living). Children in the household are: Brewsten “Bruce”, Manda, Georgia, Toy and Kissie Prichard. Their daughter Larner shown born June 1896 in the 1900 census is no longer shown with the family.

Note: Is daughter Larner(?) one of the two childhood deaths?

In the 1920 census of the 9th Civil Dist. of Putnam Co., TN, Benjamin “Ben” McMillan Prichard 47 years old is head of household md to Adelaide “Adlaid” Fisher, 45 years old. Children in the household are: Georgia, Toy, Myrtle & June Prichard.

[NAME CHANGE: PRICHARD TO DENNY: Sometime between 1920 & 1930.](#)

Did Ben Denny change his name legally? I know that Bruce and Myrtle and apparently Amanda used the name Denny. Did they change it as a group, or did it just become common usage?

According to the 1930 census of the 7th Civil Dist. of Putnam Co., TN Benjamin “Ben” McMillan PRICHARD now goes by the surname of DENNY. He is listed as Benjamin P. Denny, 56 years old married to Adelaide “Adlade” (Fisher), 56 years old. The only child living with them is Gerald/Gearld Denny. This must be June Denny from the 1920 census.

Buried Judd Cemetery, located in the 8th Dist., near the water plant. At one time called Bussell Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN). Along side Ben and Adelaide Denny is a grave for Kissie.

Buried in Judd Cemetery close to Benjamin “Ben” Prichard/Denny are Sam B. Allison & his wife Martha Jane (Brown) Allison. They are the parents of Bertha Maude Allison who married Brewsten “Bruce” Prichard/Denny, s/o Benjamin “Ben” McMillan Prichard/Denny & Adelaide Fisher. Buried along side them is: Tennessee F. “Tennie” Allison, sister of Sam B. Allison, never married - William Philmore “Billy” Allison, Pvt. Co. C 1st TN Vol. Spanish American War, brother of Sam B. Allison, William who married Avo Martin Bussell – Mary Elitha Allison, sister of Sam B. Allison, Mary married 1st Lum Herren and 2nd Farris Whitson Henley, s/o Amando “Ammon” Pasada Henley & Malinda A. “Linda” Herron – Elvira Clementine (Ellis) Allison, mother of Sam B., Tennessee & Mary Allison listed above.

There father Joseph Harra “Joe Harra” Allison was born 15 June 1833, TN, s/o John & Nancy Allison. Joseph Allison married Elvira Clementine Ellis, d/o Elijah S. Ellis Jr. & Margaret “Peggy” McCaleb. He died 26 February 1888 and was buried on the Ewin Herrin farm. They had twelve children.

Notes from Sharon Bowman: Myrtle is my husband's grandmother: Myrtle Denny married James Arthur BRYANT. My husband's great grandfather was Benjamin “Ben” DENNY (nee PRICHARD/PRICHETT and all those other spellings that make research so difficult) who married Adelaide FISHER. The family story was that Ben took the name DENNY in honor of the man who raised him. I know of at least two of his children who carried the name DENNY; Bruce and Myrtle (DENNY) BRYANT, my husband's grandmother. I have been looking for both his possible birth father and his "real" father. Ben and Adelaide are buried in the Judd Cemetery in Putnam Co., TN.

Myrtle was the 2nd wife of James Arthur Bryant. His first wife was Mary Jane Eller b. 29 July 1893 and d. 11 April 1928. James Arthur and Myrtle's first child was born 20 December 1930 so he and Myrtle would have been married between April 1928 and Dec. 1930.

Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! You don't know how much you have helped. If you come up with anything on how Ben and Sophronia came to be in James Mills Denny's household, please let me know. My husband's mother passed away about two years ago. The only clue we had that Ben Denny was something other than a Denny was a three generation family tree that she had completed for our teenage daughter. She had written "Ben Denny (Prichett)"----so much from so little:-)

We received your package yesterday. I saw my husband get excited over genealogy almost for the first time. The information that you sent is about people he knows, and he is beginning to make the connections. The "Tish" Denny Garret listed in the packet, daughter of Ralph, is one of our best friends.

Incidentally, it was interesting to note that the Allison Book was done by Della "Pat" Franklin. I owe so much to this woman. She completed a huge genealogical work, "The Clouse Clan" Book. My father, Haston Clouse, bought one for each of his children in the mid-seventies. Little did I know that I would owe so much to her efforts. I became hooked on genealogy when trying to document "First Family of Tennessee" status through George CLOUSE, and used her work for clues to appropriate documents. I learned as I went and would not have even known where to begin. The book is even typed on a typewriter, not a computer! I cannot imagine the huge undertaking.
