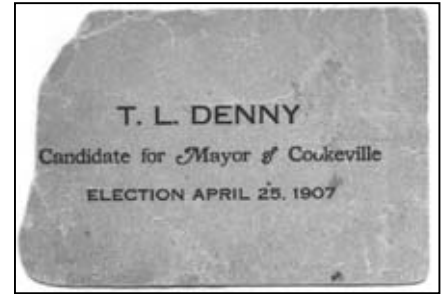


MAYOR DENNY
Beats Gregory by 83 Votes and
Carries Every Ward
ALDERMEN MIXED UP

The agony is over and, the baby is named. The city election held today, Thursday, was very quiet and a fair vote was polled. The citizens ticket was successful in the mayor’s race but lost two aldermen in the First ward and one in the Second ward, their nominees having no opposition in the Third.

Judge Denny not only carried every ward, but the Third ward alone gave him a majority over Gregory’s total vote.

The First ward delivered the goods to its master and in accordance with the ward scheme of salvation.

The Second ward could only come half way electing one alderman on each ticket, while the candidate who was on both tickets was defeated. This seems impossible, and must be a result of Jackson county politics.

The Third ward was there with the pepper. The hill-billies got theirs. They don’t know much, but are terribly “sot” in their ways.

The election proved that a large majority of our voters want a new deal. Will they get it?

This election for Mayor of Cookeville, Putnam Co., TN was won by Thompson Luther Denny s/o Jonathan Denny & Agnes Thompson.
