P. 255. - Zachariah Denny's Estate.

The following refunding bonds - were produced in open Court for probate to wit. - one signed by Lucy Woodson, + B. G. Woodson's Another signed by Elisabeth H. Denny + Timothy Denny's - Another signed by Timothy Denny + John S. Denny's - Another signed by John S. Denny + Jonathan Denny's - another signed by James Denny + William Denny's Another signed by William Denny + James Denny's - Another signed by Catherine Denny + John S. Denny's Another signed by Jonathan Denny + John S. Denny's Also one other signed by Timothy Denny + Catharine Denny, making nine in all, and the execution of all, which bonds were duly proved in open Court by the oaths of Francis M. Orange, subscribing witness thereto and ordered to be filed and recorded. (September Court - 1852.)

P. 166. - (February term Court - 1852) -

Denny + Bradley - Ordered that Archibald Debow, William S. Alexander + Hall S. Crain be appointed Commissioners to value the negro man Davy, belonging to William Denny + Drucilla, his wife, and Mary Bradley, and let said heirs draw for said slave and the one that draws said negro

pay to the other half of the valuation thereof and report to the next term of this court.
