He is the son of Aden S. Henley. Frank was a peddler optometrist. The woman is his wife Savannah Josephine Glover - d. 11 November 1910.

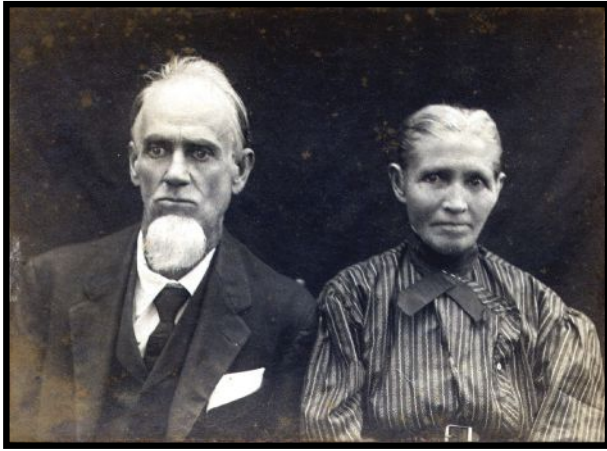

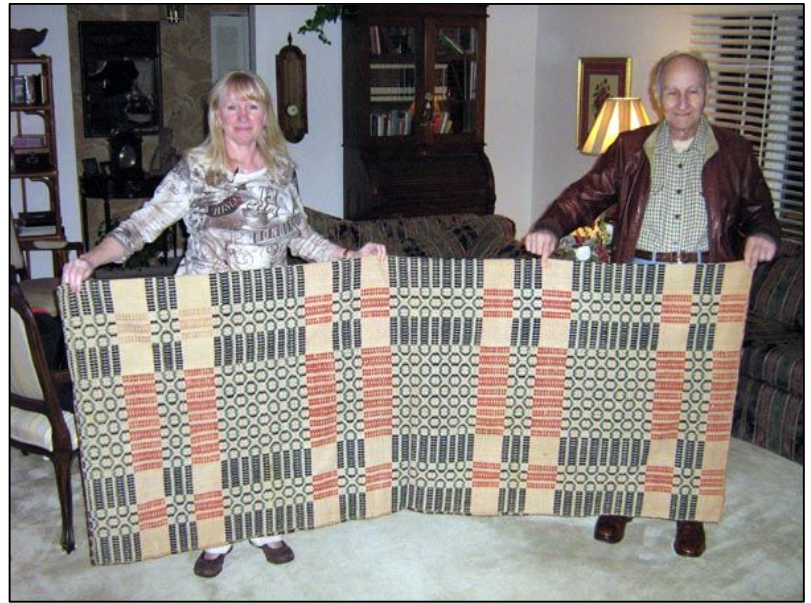

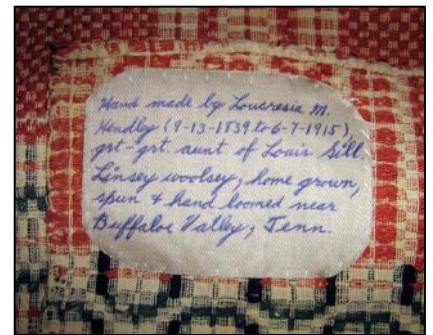

Jackson County, Tennessee was established in 1801 from Smith County, and Gainesboro, the county seat, was established as a town in 1817 and incorporated three years later. In 1801, when Jackson County was taken from Smith County, it was a part of the “Cumberland Settlement”, and it was organized for the convenience of the settlers of the “Cumberland”, who lived so far away from the available courts and the county seat. The names of the first settlers all appear on the records of the “Cumberland Settlement” and of Davidson, Smith, and Wilson Counties, all having been governed originally from the vicinity of Nashville. When first established, Jackson County included all of the present territory of Overton and Clay and parts of the other counties around it. Overton County was taken out of Jackson County in 1806. Clay County was taken equally from Jackson and Overton Counties on December 7, 1870.

1840 Census Record of Revolutionary or Military Service

On February 28, 1839, President Martin Van Buren sent a message to Congress recommending that the officers appointed to take the Federal Census of 1840 be required to make a return of the names and ages of all Revolutionary Pensioners in the United States. A provision in accordance with the recommendation of President Van Buren was incorporated in the Census Act of March 3, 1839. A special appendix of the census of 1840, gives the entire roll of pensioners of counties. The following is a transcription of that appendix.

John Henly/Henley/Hendley was listed in the Jackson County census of 1840 as being eighty-nine years old. A veteran of the Revolutionary War, he was wounded at Redding, Pennsylvania and was discharged from service on April 4, 1778 in Virginia. His participation in that war is verified by a compilation of Revolutionary War veterans receiving pensions which was written by Ernest Boyd, Attorney at Law of Putnam County, Tennessee.

Born in 1751, John Henly came to Dodson Branch from North Carolina in the late 1700's. He was given a land grant of six hundred forty acres for his service during the Revolutionary War; the land was in the Dodson Branch area on what is now known as the Old Dodson Branch Road. John Henly had 2 known sons, Joel and John, Jr.

Joel Henly was born in North Carolina and moved with his family to Dodson Branch in the late 1700's. A minister as well as a farmer, he was the Moderator of Spring Creek Baptist Church in Dodson Branch. John Henly, Jr. was born December 7, 1829 in Tennessee. He and his wife Martha had 5 sons and 2 daughters. He died on October 23, 1895 and is buried on the family farm now owned by Nathan Judd on the Dodson Branch Road.

Jackson County, Tennessee was established in 1801 from Smith County, and Gainesboro, the county seat, was established as a town in 1817 and incorporated three years later. In 1801, when Jackson County was taken from Smith County, it was a part of the “Cumberland Settlement”, and it was organized for the convenience of the settlers of the “Cumberland”, who lived so far away from the available courts and the county sear. The names of the first settlers all appear on the records of the “Cumberland Settlement” and of Davidson, Smith and Wilson Counties, all having been governed originally from the vicinity of Nashville. When first established, Jackson County included all of the present territory of Overton and Clay and parts of the other counties around it. Overton County was taken out of Jackson County in 1806. Clay County was taken equally from Jackson and Overton Counties on December 7, 1870.

Linsey-woolsey (less often, **woolsey-linsey** or in Scottish English, **wincey**) is a coarse [twill](#) or [plain-woven fabric woven](#) with a [linen warp](#) and a [woollen weft](#). Similar fabrics woven with a cotton warp and woollen weft in [Colonial America](#) were also called linsey-woolsey or wincey.^{[1][2]} The name derives from a combination of *lin* (an archaic word for [flax](#), whence "linen") and *wool*. This textile has been known since ancient times; known as [Shatnez](#) in Hebrew, the [Torah](#) and hence [Jewish law](#) explicitly forbid wearing it.
