SPRINGFIELD -- Funeral services for **Anne Draper (Jane) Quarles**, 74, of Springfield, were held today, Monday, Aug. 28, at 11 a.m. at the chapel of Austin and Bell Funeral Home. Burial will be today, Monday, Aug. 28, at 3 p.m. in Rob Draper Cemetery in Gainesboro.

Mrs. Quarles died Friday, Aug. 25, 2006, at her residence.

She was born Jan. 29, 1932, in Gainesboro to the late James Mack and Pearl Darwin Draper.

Mrs. Quarles was a member of First United Methodist Church in Springfield.
