Funeral services for Mrs. D. C. Cannon, wife of Comer Cannon, popular rural carrier, were conducted at the Paran Methodist Church Monday afternoon by the rev. Dean Stroud, pastor of the Cookeville Methodist Church of which Mrs. Cannon had been a member for many years.

Mrs. Cannon died at her home on First Street late Sunday afternoon after a long illness. She had been in failing health for more than a year, and in recent months her condition grew more critical and she was confined to her home until her death.

Born and reared near Cookeville, Mrs. Cannon had spent a large portion of her life here. Before her marriage she was Miss Henrietta Kuykendall, and was a beloved woman among her many acquaintances.

Besides her husband she is survived by one son, James, L. Cannon; a brother, James Kuykendall, of Cookeville, and two sisters, Mrs. M. O. Bean of Cookeville, and Mrs. Elijah Wilhite, Mrs. Stanton Bohannon, and Mrs. Sara Robinson.
