Mrs. Donna Farley Boyd of Gordonsville died at 2:12 a.m. Monday morning October 1, 2012 at her Hillcrest Circle home following a long battle with cancer. She was 63.

Her funeral services were conducted Wednesday afternoon, October 3rd from the Carthage Chapel of Sanderson Funeral Home. Eld. Charles Allen Gentry and Rev. Earl Dirkson officiated at the 1 p.m. services and interment followed in the Farley family lot in Smith County Memorial Gardens.

Born Donna Ruth Farley in Lebanon on January 18, 1949 and reared in the Club Springs Community, she was one of four children and the oldest child of the late Buford Farley who died September 22, 1991 at the age of 69 and Lillie Mae Grisham Farley who died November 15, 2008 at the age of 86.
