Pg. 326 – John Tucker was the son of Lewis Tucker and Melissa Williams of Silver Point, TN. He was the first married to Mary Susan “Sudie” Mitchell. They were the parents of three children: Buna, who married Durwood Brown, Bradley, and James.

John’s second wife was Samantha Sherell. They were the parents of nine children: Carmie married Jesse Can; Nell married Jack Hughes; Johnnie married James Randolph; Georgia did young; Jessie married Edward Booker; Albert Lewis married Fay Alcorn; Ernest Boyd married Keeble Phillips; Douglas died young; and Mary Ann

married Jack Higgins. John was a justice of the peace and chairman of the Putnam County Court while he was in his 20’s. He studied law and was admitted to the bar in early life and was a member for over 60 years. He was a merchant and buyer of pulpwood in Double Springs, TN.
