

THOMAS T. NICHOLAS LINEAGE

Thomas T. Nicholas was born in Pennsylvania on 18 August, 1783 and is possibly the son of the Thomas Nicholas mentioned in the family Bible who died 27 January, 1831, age 73 years. Thomas T. was married to Susannah Travis on December, 1868. Thomas T. Nicholas died 5 October, 1858. Both were buried in the family cemetery near Falling Water River in what is now Putnam County, Tennessee. The Nicholas family ran a mill on Falling Water River.

Thomas T. and Susannah Travis Nicholas were the parents of thirteen children:

1. Elizabeth "Besty" born 10 April 1807, died 6 August 1853. She married George Maxwell on 12 January 1829.
2. David born 17 September 1808, died in Missouri. He married Amanda C. Bounts (*Bounds*) on 8 November 1832.
(David Nicholas, died 15 May 1896, MO. Buried: Mt. Zion Cemetery, Howell Co., Benton Twp., MO. He married Amanda C. Bounts, b. 5 June 1815, TN – d. 5 August 1894, MO, d/o Thomas Bounts & Margaret Armstrong.. Source: James Evertt Nicholas IV, lives in Japan).
3. William M. born 29 March 1810. He married Nancy (surname unknown) on 16 October 1831. It is believed he went to West Tennessee.
4. Eleanor born 29 December 1811, (death date unknown). She first married Daniel Morgan Allison on 7 May 1832. Her second marriage was to Levi Phillips on 5 June 1845.
5. Jonathan born 26 December 1813, died 7 March 1851. He was married to Nancy Griffith on 17 July 1851. This could have been a second marriage for him.
6. Thomas Travis born 9 November 1815, died in Lawrence County, Arkansas. He was married to Glapha Buck on 14 August 1836. His second marriage was to Arselar Moon on 5 October 1846.
7. **Judith** born 25 January 1818, died 23 January 1848. She is my ancestor. Her first marriage was to **Wade H. Wallace**, *s/o Samuel Wallace* on 3 December 1836. They had one son who died young. Her second marriage was to **Isaac Alexander Huddleston** on 18 August 1842. They were the parents of three children, **Byram Frank Huddleston** (my ancestor) *md Ruth Jared*, **Elizabeth "Betty" Huddleston** *md William James Jared* and **a daughter** who died in infancy.
8. Mary "Polly" born 1 April 1820, died in Harrison County, Missouri, on 5 September 1902. She was married to Bethuel Buck on 17 November 1836.
9. James E. born 15 March 1822, died in Missouri. He married Jane E. Gilliland on 23 March 1841.
10. Lincoln born 31 March 1824, died in Missouri. He married Mary Bohannon on 27 July 1845. (Was his second wife Jane Buck?)
11. Anderson Whitley born 15 September 1826 (no further record).

12. Zenith Bloomington born 9 October 1828, died 1 June 1876. He married Elizabeth Peek on 4 April 1850.
13. Henry McKinney born 26 March 1833; died 10 September 1913. He married Sarah Ann Peek in October 1855. The Peek girls were sisters.
