William Billingsley (b. May 5, 1797 – d. 1841) came to Jackson County, Tennessee from Sequatchie Valley, Tennessee in 1798, married Ferby Brown (b. July 5, 1797 – d. July 19, 1838), the daughter of Thomas Brown and Nancy Litton. Children of William Billingsley and Ferby Brown are: Susannah Billingsley (b. April 19, 1819 – d. October 23, 1894) married 1st Amos Jackson, married 2nd Silas Redmon Jackson, John Billingsley (b. July 30, 1820), Thomas B. Billingsley (b. November 11, 1822 – d. June 25, 1900) married Louisa Jackson, Nancy Billingsley (b. February 21, 1824 – d. February 16, 1900) married Charles Jackson, Walter S. Billingsley (see below).

Walter S. Billingsley (b. April 2, 1827 – d. 1863) during the Civil War; married Sally Jackson. Children of Walter (Wat) Billingsley and Sally Jackson were: John Litton Billingsley (see below), William Billingsley, Mary E. Billingsley married Sampson Medlin.

John Litton (b. October 11, 1859 – d. March 23, 1910), married Martha Petty (b. March 3, 1859 – d. May 11, 1933), the daughter of James Petty and Polly Alexander, Martha is buried in the Billingsley Cemetery near Shady Grove in Jackson County, TN. Children of John Litton Billingsley and Martha Petty, all born in Jackson County, TN were: Mary (Merry) Billingsley (b. June 15, 1882) married Charlie Pippin, Mazy K. Billingsley (b. July 18, 1885) married Dayton Aytes, Edward Cleveland (Cleve) Billingsley (b. June 27, 1887 – d. January 23, 1969) married Laura Pippin, John L. Billingsley (b. September 16, 1889), Sally B. Billingsley (b. September 16, 1891 – d. December 20, 1975), Mattie Tennessee Billingsley (see below).

Mattie Tennessee Billingsley (b. April 15, 1897 – d. June 10, 1983) married October 15, 1916 Willie Okley Fox (b. October 1, 1897 – d. January 16, 1978), the son of Sidney Columbus Fox and Michel Candis Jackson. Children of Mattie Tennessee Billingsley and Sidney Columbus Fox all born in Jackson Co., TN are: Esteen Fox (b. July 18, 1918) married Jo Flatt, William Collie Fox (named for his uncle William Collie Billingsley) (b. April 6, 1920) married January 31, 1942 Ada Jewel Carter (b. February 15, 1921) the

daughter of Oliver Lee Carter and Alise Lena Hopkins, Mazola Fox (b. August 4, 1922) married Loid Cecil Anderson, Aaron Fox (b. June 25, 1925 – d. February 4, 1966) married Ruby Goosbly, Truman Fox (b. May 1, 1930) married August 28, 1953 Willene Loftis, Houston Fox (b. April 11, 1936) married Ruth Aline Wheeler, Evelyn Lee Fox (b. The heirs of James M. Billingsley dec'd have honored their father with a \$75.00 tombstone. (*James M. Billingsley – b. 11 May 1830 was the s/o William Billingsley & Ferby Brown. He was first married to Sophia Jackson and 2nd to Louverna Birdwell. James M. Billingsley died 5 March 1903, he is buried in the Billingsley Cemetery, Jackson Co., TN.*

BILLINGSLEY CEMETERY, Jackson Co., TN. From Gainesboro take Hwy 56 toward Baxter. Turn right on Shepardsville Road (290) a little past Rush Fork Road you will turn to the right side on Shady Grove Road. Go until the road forks bearing to the right. The cemetery will be one mile from the fork and 4/10 of a mile from a house on your right with mail box number 540. Stop before staring down a small drop. The cemetery will be on your left about 1,000 feet from the road at the end of a point enclosed by a page wire fence. It is very heavily grown up with large trees in it. There are a lot of field stone markers and a lot of graves without a marker. Shown location by Mr. Edd Carter and recorded 24 April 1999 with Eldon L. Moss.

ELIAS⁴ JACKSON (*EDWARD³, NATHAN², (UNKNOWN)¹*)^{6,7,8} was born Abt. 1776 in Burke County, NC, and died Bef. 1850 in Jackson County, TN. He married **EDITH STANLEY^{9,10,11}** Abt. 1795 in Guilford County, NC. She was born May 04, 1775 in NC, and died 1876 in Jackson County, TN.

Notes for ELIAS JACKSON:

"Elias Jackson and family, William Billingsley and family all came from North Carolina in 1760. They settled on "Rush Fork" of Flynn's Creek in the territory, which is known as Jackson County, Tennessee."

Elias Jackson was born circa 1776. He and Edith Stanley (born circa 1775) were married in about 1795 in Guilford County, NC. The 1800 census for Burke County, NC shows Elias with a wife and daughter under 10 years old. He owned land on a branch of Crooked Creek as revealed in NC Land Grants #3445 and #3446. As recorded in Rutherford County records, he paid \$75 for 50 acres of land on both sides of the Main Broad River. This deed was executed on March 7, 1809 and recorded in Book 24-26 on March 14, 1811. The transaction was witnessed by Joseph Jackson and Nancy Stanley. He sold, on 12 Oct 1810, the same 50 acre tract,, which was described "where Jackson now lives" and soon thereafter moved to Jackson County, TN (before 1815). The family settled in the southeast corner of present day Jackson County only a few miles east (and over a ridge) from Abner Chaffin, who lived on Flynn's Creek. On November 7, 1815 Elias purchased 10 acres, including a house on Rush Fork of Flynn's Creek. The following year he

purchased two additional acres which included a sugar orchard on top of a ridge. The 1840 census finds Elias and his brother Azaria(h)s living in the 11th Civil District of Jackson County. He died before 1850 in Jackson County, TN. A lawsuit (Alice Pippin Clemens vs. the Estate of Elias Jackson) names Elias' children. Edith died in 1876, living with her son Joseph at the time of her death, revealed by court documentation of "Estate vs. Inventory of Edith Jackson". Source - Rod Medders, 01/10/00.

Nancy Owenby married (1) a Mr. Stanley and (2) William Jackson, nephew of Elias; she and Joseph witnessed the deed of Charles Stanley to Elias Jackson, all in Rutherford County, NC (part that was later McDowell County and now Buncombe County, next to Burke County).
