William F. Young was born 15 April, 1744, and his wife Elizabeth Huff was born 27 October, 1754. They were married on 25 March, 1770 and lived in Virginia. They came to what is now western Putnam County about 1811. With them came their eight children, some of whom were grown and married with families of their own; and they all settled in a general area on Young's Fork of Little Indian Creek. They were farmers, but were also skilled blacksmiths and carpenters, and were well-suited to meet the challenges of life in a new land.

The oldest of their children was David Adolphous Young, born 18 June, 1772. He married Elizabeth Vance, whose parents were James Vance and Margaret Reno, and they had eight children. The oldest was Isaac Young. The next was James Vance Young; followed by John Young, born 19 May, 1811, who married Priscilla Hawley; William Fredrick Young married Mary Webb; Lewis Vance Young, who married Nancy Armstrong; Mary Vance "Polly" Young, born 10 November, 1818, who married John Doyle Lee; Lavina Young, born 25 September, 1820, who married John Doyle Lee; and David Isaac Young.

Jacob Young married first Mary Boren, in 1880, and their children were Squire Boren, born 1802; John born 1804; William born August 28, 1806; Alfred Douglas born April 13, 1808; and Elizabeth born 1810. Mary Boren Young died in Winter Quarters, Council Bluffs, Iowa, in 1848. Jacob Young, after separation from Mary, married Polly Huff. He died in 1842 in Madison County, Tennessee.

Susanna Young married John Porterfield. She died in 1832.

John Young married Matilda Gibson in 1811. Their children were Allen born August 10, 1814; Adolphia born February 27, 1816; John Harmon born February 20, 1818; and Annie born March 25, 1819. John Young died in May, 1835, in Nashville. His wife Matildam when she learned that he was ill, made a frantic journey to Nashville via horseback and riverboat but was unable to reach him before he died.

Mark Young married Ruth Raulston. They had ten children; William Frederick born December 5, 1807; James born January 20, 1809; John born 1811; Peter born April 22, 1816; Marley born 1824; Patsy; Elizabeth; Polly, Leandra born May 14, 1818; and Ruth.

Naomi Young married John Douglass. He was apparently a prominent citizen of the community, because his name appears frequently in documents of the time as he officiated in minor legal matters. September 16, 1815; Newton born January 9, 1817; Hampton Wade born September 14, 1821; Merena born May 12, 1818; Elizabeth born May 31, 1823; and Young Faucia born November 28, 1824. After her death in 1824, Adam married again, and the Marleys subsequently moved to Texas.

The youngest child of William and Elizabeth was Samuel Young, who remained in the area and lived in what is now called Brindley Hollow. He was married three times and had three distinct families.

The first marriage was to Elizabeth George on August 24, 1813. Their children were Emily born in 1814; William F. born November 9, 1819; and Minerva born 1821.

Samuel's second marriage was to Patsy Firzpatrick, and their children were Basil born 1825; James Preston born October 3, 1826; Samuel van born May 3, 1828; and Marion born 1831.

His third marriage was to Elizabeth Dickens, born 1814, and their children were Elizabeth born 1844; Mary Ann Born 1846; Clarisa Adeline born August 5, 1849; Virginia M. born 1851, and Letta S. born 1854.

Samuel died in 1856 and his widow Elizabeth married a Glover.
