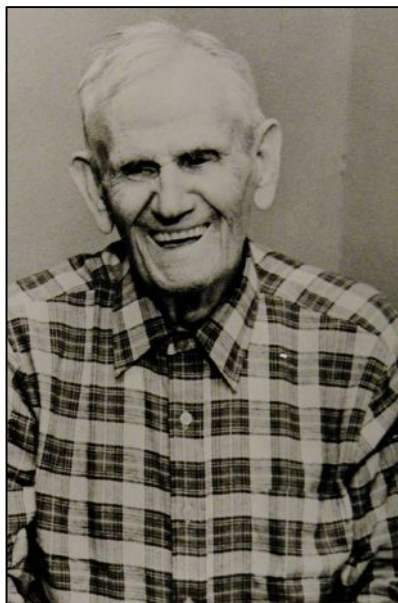

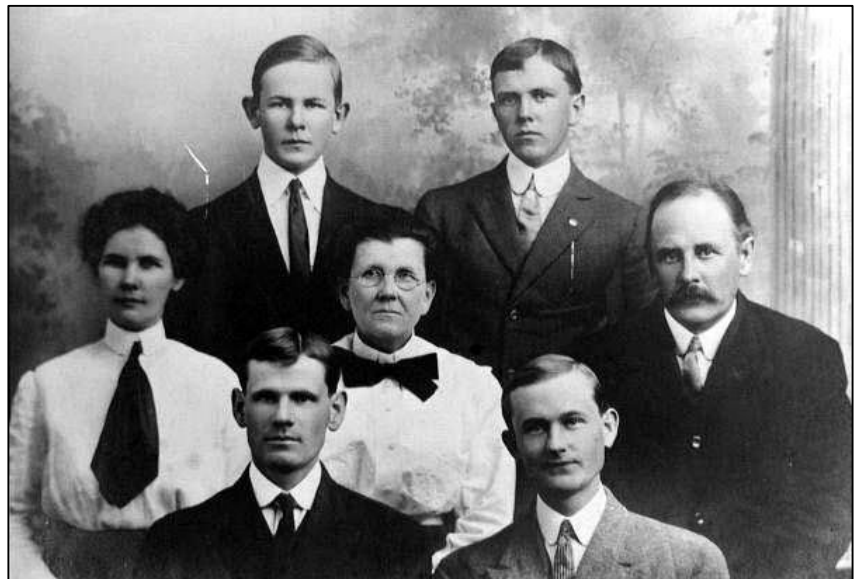

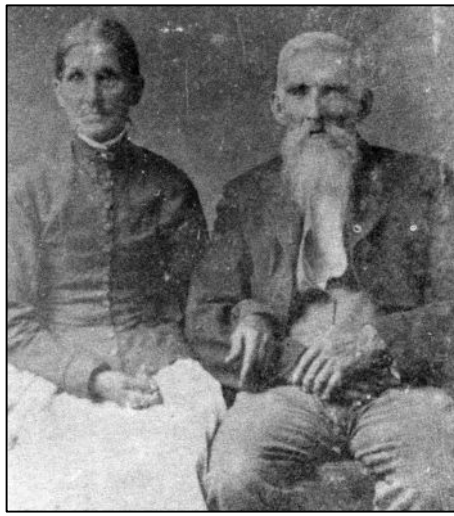

He studied agriculture at Tennessee Tech and became a recognized authority on dairy farming. He was appointed in 1934 to administer the U.S. government's marketing program in St. Louis under the Agriculture Adjustment Act of 1933.

**He was born Oct. 11, 1905, the eighth of nine children of Squire Harvey Richard Shipley and Sallie Welch Shipley of Cookeville.**

In the fall of 1924, he entered Tennessee Polytechnic Institute, where he majored in agriculture. In Feb. 1930, he took a position managing the Champaign County Milk Producers Association in Champaign, Illinois, and while there, attended the University of Illinois to study marketing and economics.

He later served as assistant manager with Sanitary Milk Producers Association in St. Louis for a time before being appointed to head the U.S. government's milk regulatory program in St. Louis.

He also served in the military, beginning in January 1943 with the U.S. Army Quartermaster Corp.

Working out of Wilmington, North Carolina, he was responsible for procuring milk and dairy products for military bases in several states. He was later sent to set up the same program on the west coast, working out of Los Angeles to procure milk for military units in several western states.

After the military service, Shipley returned to St. Louis and resumed his duties as market administrator for the milk regulatory program, one of only 39 such positions in the country. He retired in 1975 at the age of 70.

For his long service to the dairy industry, Shipley was named to the Dairy Hall of Honors at the University of Missouri-Columbia.

His family includes four sons, Pat Shipley of Aurora, Colorado, and his wife, Dianne Barnes Shipley, Mike Shipley of St. Louis and his wife, Kathleen Neuenschwander Shipley, Larry Shipley of Vermillion, South Dakota, and Steve Shipley of West Plains, Missouri; two grandsons,

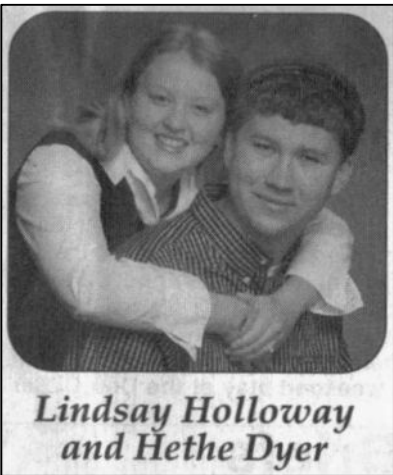
