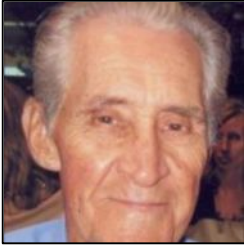


Ralph Arnold Maxwell Obt.
