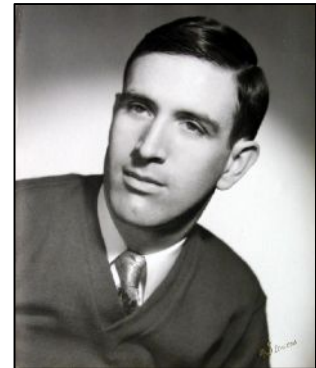

If you go to the link I give below, then go to the far right column on the page where it says "Archives". There will be a drop down list box there where it says "search type". Click on the arrow to make the list appear and at the top of the list will be, not Shelby County, but 3 statewide record categories, where you can choose any of the 3 categories, and then below that choose a county and enter a name and optional years. It works as an index giving information to order the record, but the actual name and death/marriage/divorce date is also given. Also if there are many records that meet your search criteria, all those will be listed. You are also given a link to order the record from the state health department.

Death record results contain name, date, age, county, marital status, race, gender, and file number. It doesn't get any better for free.
