John Austin Sr. was born in NC, according to the 1850 census. His parents are unknown at present. He married Rachel Denny, d/o James and Ester Denny, on June 21, 1802 in Wayne Co., KY. Rachel was born in 1784 and died about 1818. She and John Sr. are both buried in Austin-Anderson Cemetery, Lost Creek in White Co., TN. John Sr. had seven children: William, Jude, Tamar, Hannah, James, Elizabeth, and John Jr. Austin (my great grandfather). After Rachel died, John Sr. married Catherine Haston in 1819. She was born December 25, 1776 in VA and died June 27, 1843. She was buried in Austin-Anderson Cemetery, Lost Creek. The children of John Sr. and Catherine were: Pleasant, Emaline, Robert, Susan, Bird, and William Edward Austin. After the death of Catherine in 1843, John Sr. married Mary Ann Todd, January 17, 1884. No children. Shortly before her death, at an elderly age, a granddaughter of John Austin states: "the Austin's came with the Anderson family, traveling by ox cart, cutting their own road across the Allegheny Mountains."

John Austin Jr. my great grandfather, served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. One day news came that he would be marching by his homeplace. His two little boys John Robert "Bob" Austin age 5 and my grandfather William Edward "Bill" age 3 got up on the gate posts to see their father march by. He could wave at them but not speak. The year was about 1863.
