Martha Oval, Eva, Floy, Margie & Leon "Dick" Lynch are the children of Abe Lynch (b. 1877 – d. 1961) buried in Crestlawn Cemetery, Putnam Co., TN & Martha Jane Wilkerson (1881-1916) buried in Dixon Springs Cemetery, north of Carthage, TN. She was relocated from the Lynch Cemetery originally located in Sullivans Bend near Chestnut Mound, TN. The area where the Lynch Cemetery was located was flooded when the Cordell Hull Dam and reservoir were completed. The entire cemetery was relocated to Dixon Springs by the Corps of Engineers. The Corps of Engineers published a book about the relocation of all the cemeteries around Carthage to Dixon Springs. Dixon Springs is in Smith Co., TN. Martha Jane Wilkerson Lynch died soon after Martha Oval Lynch was born. Martha Oval Lynch (b. 1917 – d. 11 January 2001, Hendersonville, TN).
