Records from the Bible of Captain Walton Smith and Marian R. Black Smith, now in the possession of Major Rutledge Smith, Lebanon Road, Nashville, Tennessee.

Marriages:

John Puckett, born February 26, 1764, in Botetourt County, VA, and Rhoda Lida, born 1784 of White County, TN, married on December 25, 1809.

The above are the parents of Matilda Puckett, who married T.J. Smith. They were the parents of Walton Smith. Record of John Puckett, found in Bureau of Pensions. He died September 4, 1844.

Walton Smith and Marion R. Black, married in Lebanon, Wilson County, TN, May 14, 1896. Elva Cecil Smith and C.H. Tholman, married in Cookeville, TN, May 2, 1899.

Walton Smith, born April 23, 1837, in DeKalb Co., TN, died March 8, 1903, in Cookeville, Putnam County, TN.

Rutledge Smith, born August 1, 1870 in the southwest corner of Putnam County, TN.

Elva Cecil Smith, born in Cookeville, Putnam County, TN, June 11, 1841.

Marian R. Black, wife of Walton Smith, was born in Charleston, SC, January 14, 1841.

Mrs. Margaret A. Black, born in Charleston, SC, May 1, 1812, died in Cookeville, Putnam County, TN, January 21, 1894.

Mrs. Marion Richardson Smith, wife of Walton Smith, born in Charleston, SC, January 14, 1841; married to Walton Smith in Monroe, Walton County, GA, May 19 1864; died in Cookeville, Putnam County, TN, of heart failure, April 19, 1894. She lived and died a true and humble Christian and is now safe and happy in the realms of bliss and eternal glory.

John P. Black, died October 6, 1845, at Savannah, GA, age 27 years 6 months.
