(1823-1895)
Son of Hugh & Nancy (Jared) Wallace

January 28, 1894

In the name of God, I, Wm. J. Wallace, have this day made this my last will and Testament as follows: at my death that Elizabeth Ann Wallace, my wife, have everything that we own and possess both real and personal property, except that Adalaid Printice have ten dollars and that Amanda and Stephen Prichard have ten dollars and that Hugh E. Wallace have ten dollars and that John L. Wallace have ten dollars and that James Wade Wallace have ten dollars and that Robert E. Wallace have ten dollars and that Sarah Caroline and W. C. Garrison have ten dollars and that Joel L. Wallace have ten dollars and that at Bettsaan Death everything be sold and the money be equally divided among the children and that Elizabeth Ann Wallace be appointed my executor to this will without giving bond this the 27th day of January 1894.
