He predicted Adair Co., KY had a great future and died very wealthy, Ref: VA REV. Rec. 8th VA Reg., Family Bible, Henry Wright Newman and C.M. Shirley.

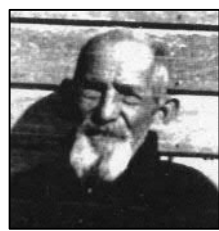

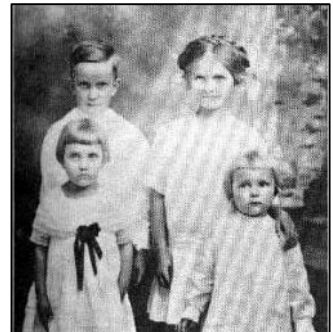

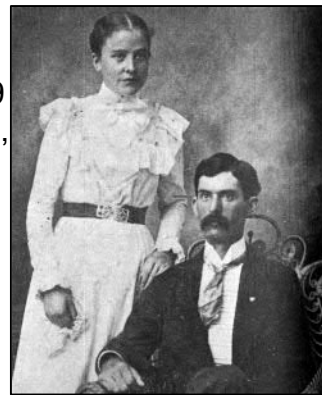

Buffalo Valley became Dist. 9, & Silver Pt., Dist. 11.

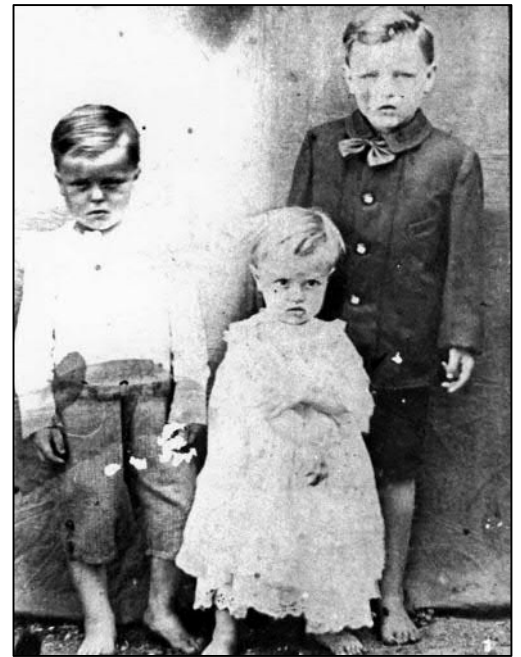

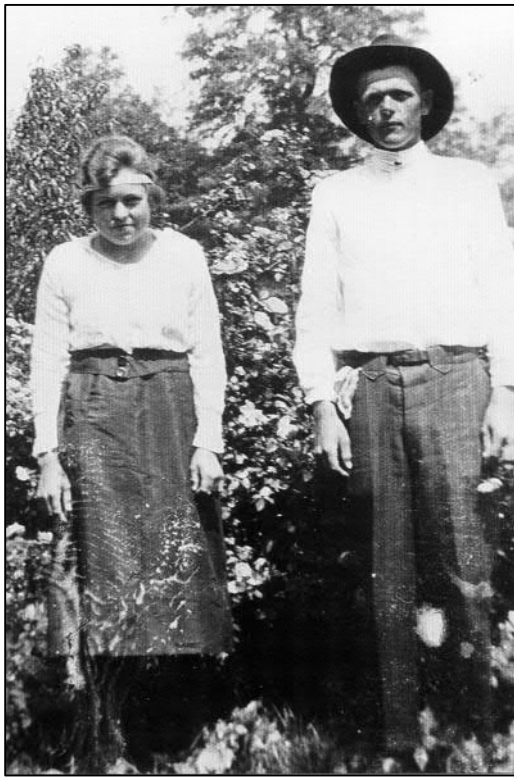

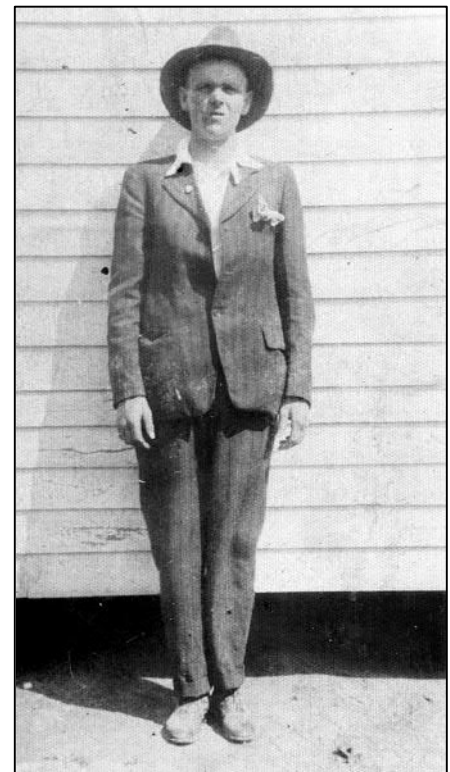
