Story of Calvin Denton “Cab” Anderson
s/o James Ellman Anderson & Eliza Sims
s/o William Garland Anderson “Long Billy” & Sarah “Sallie” Loveall

The oldest record available dates back to William Anderson and wife, Catherine Shirley who died in Cumberland County, Virginia in the 18th Century. Their son Garland (b. 1782) married Sarah Robinson (b. 1786). They traveled to Tennessee with Sarah’s family, the Robinsons, with Thomas and Judith Anderson. Thomas and Garland were brothers, and Judith and Sarah were sisters.

A son was born to Garland and Sarah in 1804. His name was William Garland. He married Sarah Loveall in 1823. On January 17, 1829 (*Putnam Co., Tennessee Cemetery book by Maurine Patton states b. January 7th 1829*) a son named James Ellman was born to William Garland and Sarah Loveall Anderson. He first married Elizabeth “Eliza” Sims (b. 1833?), and their 9 children were as follows:

1. Sarah Clementine (b. 1854; d. ?) married DuWeese.
2. Luvern (b. 1855) married Asbury Loftis
3. Gallant Alvnsen (b. 1857)
4. Martha Adivill (b. 1859) married Samuel Loftis
5. Calvin Denton “Cab” (b. July 22, 1861 – d. 30 November 1931) married September 21, 1881 to America Elizabeth Young (b. July 16, 1864 – d. March 9, 1920).
6. Lucentine (b. 1862) married William J. “Billy” Anderson, a son of Paul Thomas Anderson and Susmath “Susie” Johnson.
7. Celina (b. 1862) married Walter Pharris in 1833.
8. Alice (b. 1865) married Dan Chaffin
9. George B. (b. 1869).

James Ellman’s second wife was Judia Moore (b. November 23, 1836). Their son, Lewis, was born April 22, 1877; died April 7, 1917. James Ellman died May 23, 1914. These three are buried in Smith’s Chapel Cemetery in Putnam County, TN near the Jackson County line just off the Dodson’s Branch Road near Spring Creek Church. Jackson County records show that James Ellman’s will was executed and probated in 1873.

 7. Hop T. (b. 1909) married Lora Z. Loftis (b. 23 October 1914), daughter of Melvin Pearce Loftis & Louvinia Loftis. Melvin Pearce Loftis is the son of John P. Loftis (son of Thomas Jefferson Loftis) and Frances America Loftis (daughter of James Matt Loftis). Louvinia Loftis is the daughter of Francis Marion Loftis & Mary Jane Chaffin.

Lena Avo Anderson, the only daughter of James A. “Jim” and Maggie Lou Anderson, was born in Jackson County, Tennessee. Always having a love for school and having been influenced by two aunts who were teachers and by her high school English teacher, Miss Mary Cummins, she chose a career of teaching that extended over a period of forty-three years. During that time, she taught on the elementary, secondary, and college level without missing a year’s work and earned a B.S. Degree from Tennessee Polytechnic Institute (now Tennessee technological University) in Cookeville, Tennessee, and a M.A. Degree from George Peabody College for Teachers in Nashville, Tennessee. She received the following tribute from her former student, Janie Brown:

If I ever reach my eightieth year,
I only ask for the things listed here:
I want a good heath and an active brain
And the strength to bear my share of losses and pain.
I want to dig in the dirt and enjoy a rose;
I want to still have the desire to powder my nose.
I want to drive my car so that I can stay free.
I want to still be able to see
