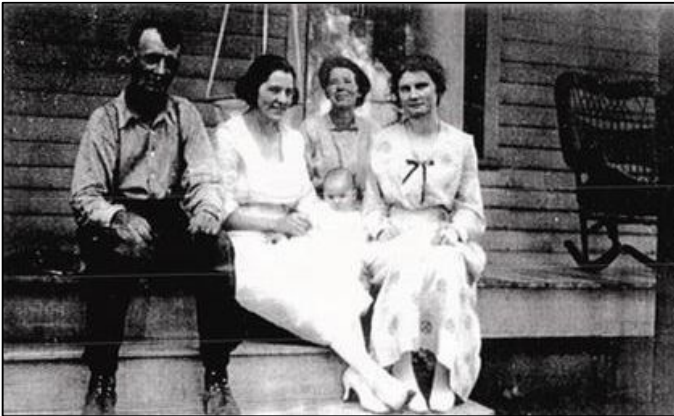

Kelly family asks public to preserve name of Kelly Road

Eastpointe, MI – Laura Kelly is hoping her words can convince city residents to avoid signing a proposal to change the name of Kelly Road to Eastpointe Boulevard.

The reason: Kelly Road represents metro-Detroit history. She happily tells the tales to prove it.

Laura Kelly is the great granddaughter of John Kelly Jr., the man whom Kelly Road was named after. In his honor, and out of respect for local history, Laura Kelly wants to keep the name of Kelly Road unchanged.

“These street names came from the early settlers of this area,” Laura Kelly said. “the names should be preserved and respected.”

Laura Kelly’s father, Kenneth Kelly, the grandson of John Kelly Jr., died 18 months ago; before the name change idea ever came about.

“My father would be very upset about this,” Kelly said.

Eastpointer resident George Lawroski is on a mission to change Kelly Road to Eastpointe Boulevard, and enact term limits for city council, the mayor and judges. He began collecting signatures last week.

Kelly, of Roseville, said she doesn’t mind either way about Lawroski’s term limit idea, but she does worry about the street name. She said before residents make a decision about whether to sign a street name change petitions, she wanted the history of Kelly Road known.

John Kelly Jr. was born on February 12, 1857 in Hamtramck. He was the son of Irish immigrant farmers who purchased 66 acres of land on Pumpkin Hook for \$6,250. When his parents died, John Kelly Jr., took over the farm that sat directly across from where Denby High School in Detroit stands now.

John Kelly Jr. was also a justice of the peace. People from all over the area walked or rode horse-drawn carriages to the Kelly farm to conduct business.

The problem was the farmhouse was located on a dirt road, as homes were back then, and people often got lost in search of it.

So, one morning, John Kelly took a piece of wood and nailing it to an oak tree at the intersection of Pumpkin Hook Road and Tailor painted KELLY'S ROAD on it.

He posted the sign on the street and people found his home much easier.

Years later, Kelly's Road was officially named Kelly Road.

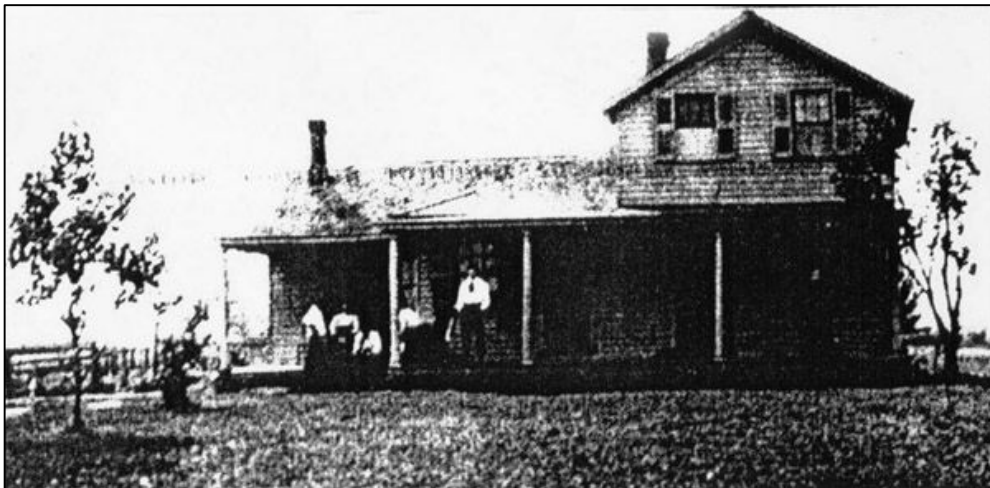
When John Kelly Jr. died, he was buried in the Assumption Grotto Cemetery where other settlers like Schoenherr, Hayes and Young were buried. Although Kelly's grave was later re-located to another cemetery, Laura Kelly said seeing those other names, like Schoenherr who also had a major road named after him, meant something important. *(John Kelly Jr. is buried in Mt. Olivet Cemetery, 17100 Van Dyke Avenue, Detroit MI 48201- (313) 365-5650).*

“These are the people who founded our cities, this is our heritage.”

Kelly said her 52 first-cousins, some of whom live in Eastpointe, and descendants of John Kelly Jr., agree.

Letter from Laura Kelly to the Editor: dated 13 March 1996 –

Dear Editor,

John Kelly Jr. was born Feb. 12, 1857 in Hamtramck, MI, son of immigrant farmers; one of eleven children. His father purchased 66 acres of farm land on Pumpkinhook Rd for \$6,250 from Fred Juif of Grosse Pointe Township. His son, John Jr. took over the farm and also served as Justice of the Peace. People seeking his services often got lost on the many dirt roads. John solved the problem by painting KELLY ROAD on a piece of wood and nailing it to an oak tree at the intersection of Pumkinhook and Tailor (Tailor Rd. is currently Houston-Whittier). When the city incorporated the area the road was officially named Kelly Rd.

A glance at plat map, circa 1875, and headstones in area cemeteries reveals names of earlier settlers lent their names to streets and avenues, i.e. Schoenherr, Gitre, Young, Cadieux, Morang, and of course Kelly!

As the 80+ descendants of “The Captain” John Kelly Jr., we think preserving the history of the community should take precedents over one person’s gains. Please consider history before casting a vote for change.

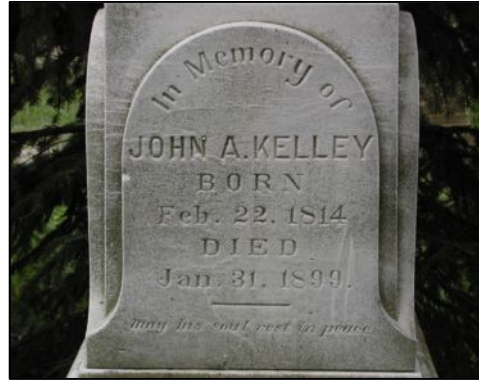
