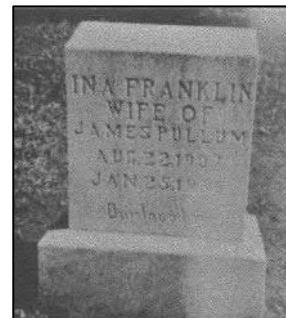

Kenneth Pullum's wife died on Friday, February 13, 2004, in Cookeville Regional Medical Center. Kenneth Pullum and his wife lived for many years on the old John Smith Denny farm. **John Smith Denny** and family members are buried behind the house in the Denny family graveyard.

Grace Gill said Kenneth Pullum moved to Baxter, Putnam Co., TN and was going to move into a trailer next to his son, maybe son, **Richard** and his wife, **Odelene Pullum** of Baxter. Apparently this is true because the John Smith Denny farm is up of sale.

Source: The farm of **John Smith Denny** was purchased years ago by **Kenneth Pullum**. In 2004 Kenneth Pullum turned 90 and decided to sell his house and land. 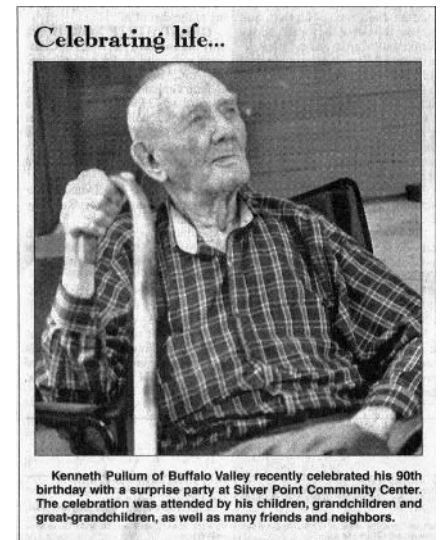

I recently found your web site and was over joyed to find some of my family members listed. My father's great grandmother was **Sarah (Sally) Pullum**. According to your web site and census records we have found, **Sarah's brother, James G. Pullum, married Elizabeth C. Plunkett**.

I found on the internet that there is a Plunkett Family Cemetery on Happy Hollow Road. In a couple of weeks, I will be coming to Tennessee with my father who is 85 years old. We would be interested to visit this cemetery. Can you tell me exactly where it is located? I was in Nashville last month, and drove down to Buffalo Valley to see if I could find it. I found Happy Hollow Road, but was unable to find the cemetery.

I did meet a lady named **Sue Brindley** who was very helpful and gave me some interesting information about the Plunketts and Pullums, but she didn't know the location of the cemetery.

Thank you for any information you may be able to provide.

Good morning Michael and Audrey:

Sarah Pullum (b.10/12/1829 - d. 5/31/1886) was the daughter of **Jennings Pullum** and **Artamissa (Mency) Hardcastle Pullum**. **Sarah married John Washington Mills** (b.2/15/1826 - d. 7/31/1890), son of **John Mills and Martha(?)**. They are listed in the 1850 census in South Division, Smith, Tennessee, John living with his parents and Sarah living with her mother and siblings. Her father, is not listed, so we assume he had already died. John and Sarah were married 11/06/1850. This marriage is listed in the Smith County Tennessee Marriage books, where her name is listed as "Sally Pullum."

John and Sarah were next found in Temperance Hall, in the 1860 census. (This makes me wonder if they were members of the Sons of Temperance or if they were merely moving for economic reasons.)

In 1870, they had moved to Vista Ridge, Pulaski County, Illinois. (You can just imagine how us southerners feel about this move!)

They eventually ended up in Mauldin, Missouri, where Sarah died in 1886. After Sarah's death, John remarried Elvira Henson. John died in 1890. John and Sarah are buried in the city cemetery in Mauldin.

They were the parents of six boys. One of their sons, Jennings Bates Mills, is my Great Grandfather. We suspect that Jennings was named after his grandfather, Jennings Pullum, and after the Bates family from Buffalo Valley, as there is no other record of Bates in our family tree. (We found a neighbor, Bird Bates, in the census records that led us to this conclusion.)

Jennings Bates Mills married Missouri Ann George in Dunklin County, Missouri on 10/13/1878. He moved his family to Texas in 1901. His son, Alonzo Calvin Mills, was my grandfather.

Because of your web site and others we have found, we have been able to trace the family of Sarah Pullum. However, John's siblings were all girls, which as you know, are hard to follow on census records. We have been unable to find out what happened to them. We also lost the trail of John's mother and father.

We suspect that Artamissa Hardcastle Pullum was somehow related to Hardin Hardcastle, as she lived very close to him. However, we have been unable to verify this. 1880 Census shows Artamissa in District 7, Putnam, Tennessee, living with her grand daughter, Mary, Mary's husband, Robert Smith, and great grandson, Willie. Her name is listed as Arlie. The census states she is 78 years old, born in North Carolina. We would like very much to know where she is buried and, of course, any tidbit of information about her family would be appreciated.

Sue was able to give us some web sites to look at death records in Tennessee. Also, she gave me some information about Pullums that might still be in the Buffalo Valley area.

I received a map yesterday from **Betty Stark** that shows the location of the Plunkett Cemetery. We are hopeful that we will be able to find it next week.

If you want the information I have about Sarah and John, I can send you a word document. I am always careful about "pushing" my family information off on others unless they really want it.

Thank you so much for answering my e-mail and for your wonderful web site. I look forward to further correspondence with you.

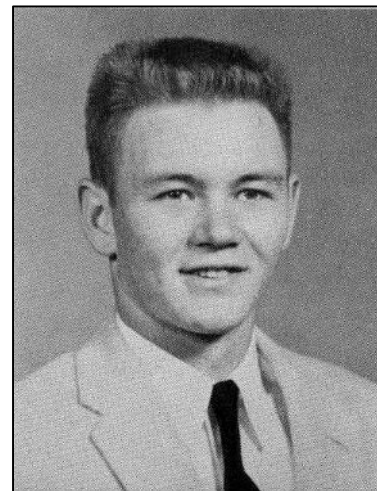

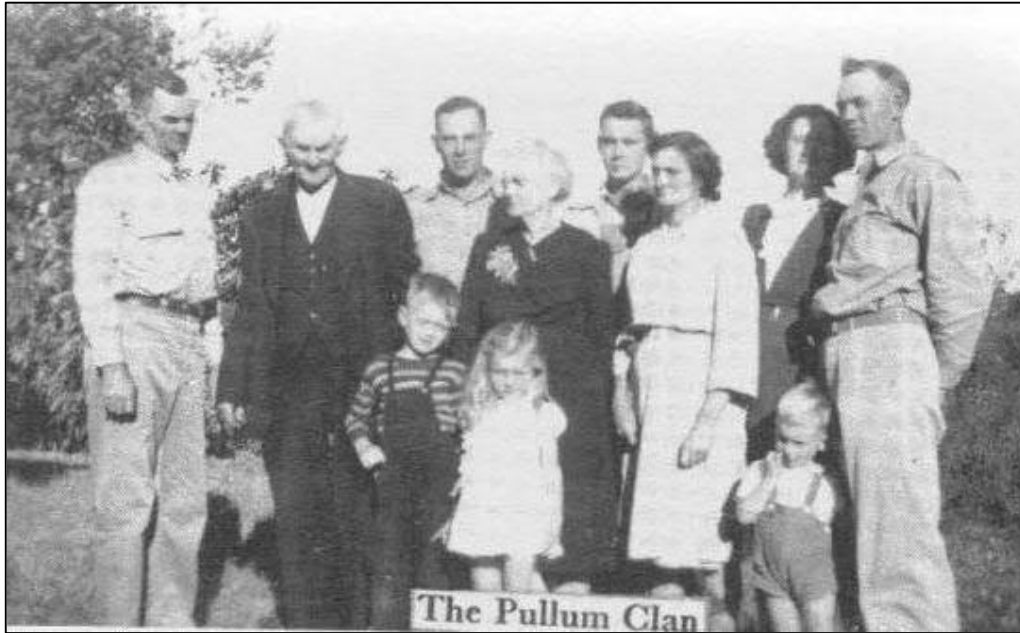
