In the name of God Amen, I **Zachariah Talley** of Sumner County and State of Tennessee being at this time pained in body but of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit. In the first place I give to my son **William P. Talley** of Cumberland Co., Virginia one dollar besides the land and negroes and other property that I gave him before I removed from Virginia to him and his heirs forever, Item, I give and bequeath unto my son **Jackey Talley** of Cumberland County and State of Virginia the property of every discription that I put him in possessions of before my removal from Virginia and I also give five hundred dollars cash to be paid to my son **Zachariah Talley** and my daughter **Charity Talley** equally in the space of two years after my decease to him and his heirs forever. Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Charity Talley the negroes and property of every discription that I put her in possession of about the time that she moved to this county and I also her one negro man named Cary and one named Kirk, two negro women one named Dilly and one named Lizza and a negro girl Betty to her and her heirs forever, Item, I give and bequeath unto my son Zachariah Talley the negros and property of every discription that I put him in possession of when he was about to remove to this county and I also give unto him a negro man named George and a negro man named Merit Also two negro women one named Sally and one named Chanin to him and his heirs forever. Item, I lend unto my granddaughter **Lucy Butterworth** during of her natural life my negro boy named Pleasant and at her decease I give the said negro boy to the heirs lawfully begotten of her own body but if she should die without any such heirs my wish is that he return to her brothers and sisters. Item, I lend unto my granddaughter **Polly Talley** daughter of Charity Tally one negro boy child named Willis during of her natural life and at her decease I give the said boy to the heirs of her own body but if there should be none to her brothers and sisters as above. Item, I lend to my granddaughter **Lucy M. Talley** during of her natural life one negro girl named Kizza and at ther dec'd I give the said negro girl with her increase to the heirs of own body but if there should be none such to return to her brothers and sisters as above directed. Item, I lend unto my granddaughter **Elija W. Tally** during her natural life one negro girl named Ede and at her decease I give the said negro girl with her increase to the heirs of her own body but if there should be none such to return as above directed. Item, I lend unto my granddaughter **Peomly W. Talley** during of her natural life one negro girl child named Evaline but at her decease I give the said negro girl with her future increase to the heirs of her own body forever but if she should die without any such heirs then to return to her brothers and sisters as above directed. Lastly I constitute and appoint my son **Zachariah Talley** and **Reuben Talley** ex'ers of this my last will and testament. In testimony where of I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th, day of April 1820.
