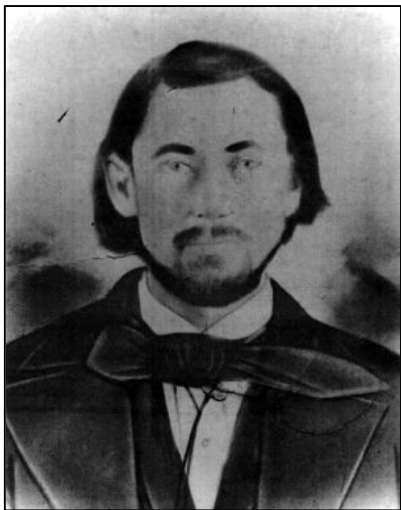


BRANSFORD BOYD (#957)

Pgs. 336 & 337: Bransford B. Boyd, born June 12, 1828, was a son of John and Elizabeth Lee Boyd. He married Eliza Jane Jared, daughter of John and Ann Carr (Kerr) Jared. They had four children: Besty Ann, Lafayette, Ervin, and George Washington Boyd, who was my grandfather.

Bransford B. Boyd was a Confederate soldier in the Civil War. He died August 1, 1861 from complications of an illness, possibly measles and was buried (back of Nichols' plot) in the old city cemetery on Magnolia Avenue in Nashville, TN. Later a memorial for him was placed in the Confederate Circle at Mount Olivet Cemetery in Nashville, TN.
