
Pg. 336 – John, born 07 March, 1896 in Putnam Co. enlisted in the army at 22. He served in France and when he returned home always wore socks because his feet were frozen in the foxholes in winter. He was honorably discharged 04 April, 1919.

Son of Thomas and Mellissa Boyd, he married Mary Lou Shanks, daughter of Van and Ellen Maynard Shanks, 30 May 1920. They had four children, Gilbert, Ralph, J. C. and Erma Dean Boyd MacDonald. He died 27 November 1967 in Warren, Michigan. Mary died 09 January, 1990 and both are buried in Crest Lawn Cemetery, in Cookeville.

Pg. 336 - James Alexander Boyd, son of John C. Boyd and Martha Holladay, was born 4 December 1843 and died 7 October 1927. He married Rhoda Frances Nichols and had six children.

In April 1861 James volunteered as a soldier in the first company of Confederate soldiers organized in Putnam Co. TN, Company F of the Sixteenth Tennessee Regiment, being the company of Capt. H. H. Dillard and the Regiment of Col. John H. Savage. During the last several months of the Civil War, he was a prisoner in the Rock Island Federal Prison in Illinois.
