**Mrs. Willie McKinley Observes 93<sup>rd</sup> Birthday**

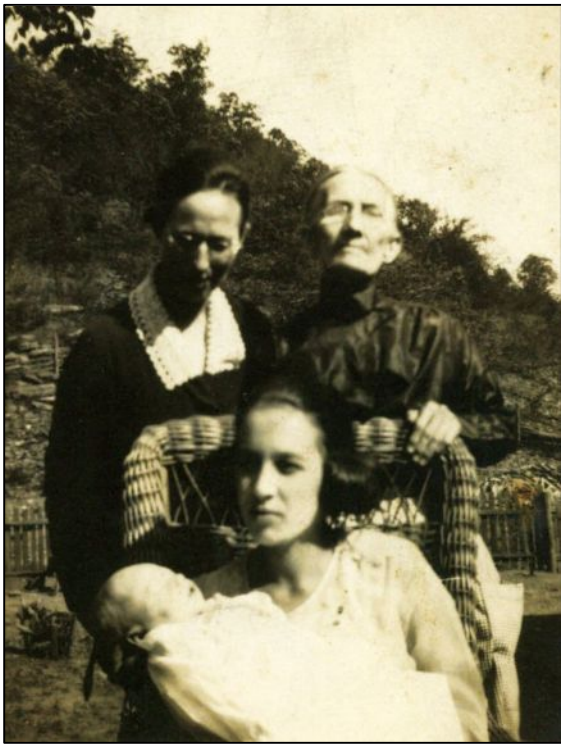
