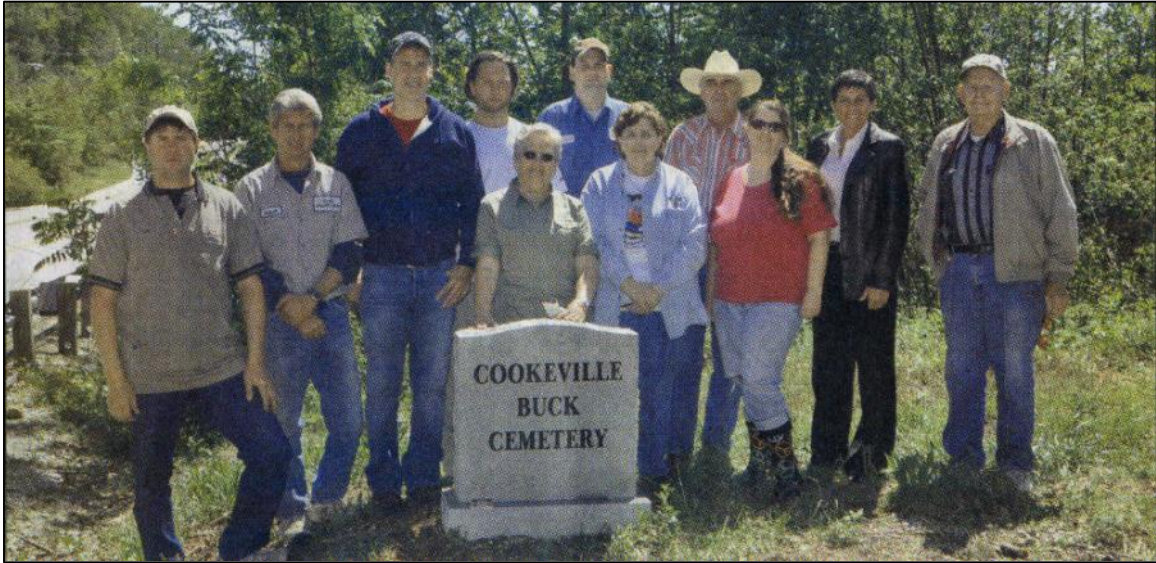


BUCK CEMETERY MARKED

A marker has been placed at the entrance of the Cookeville Buck Cemetery, which has recently been targeted as part of a clean-up effort. The cemetery, located off Ninth Street, is overgrown and volunteers have been working for weeks to clear trees and brush and to mark those graves without headstones. Previously, no sign even marked the final resting place of hundreds of former residents. This cemetery was formerly known as Old Bushtown Cemetery before being called Black Buck Cemetery and finally being renamed The Cookeville Buck Cemetery.

Weekend fatalities claimed the life of one negro identified by Putnam county officers as Fred Western, 46, of Bushtown.

George Marchbanks, 50, is in Cookeville City Hospital in critical condition from a gunshot wound received late Saturday when he was shot on a road in the "Black Bottom" settlement near Algood. Another man, Andy Garrett, 74, received a hand injury in the first of the shootings.

In Putnam County jail charged with the murder of his brother is Taft Western, 50, Dillard Murphy, 35, Algood, charged with attempted murder and Russell Copeland, Cookeville.

Officers said Fred Western was killed early Sunday morning when he was struck in the chest by a blast from a shotgun fired by his brother Taft. Taft Western was quoted by officers as saying his brother came to the home of Taft's father-in-law and started an argument. Taft said he went to his home to get his gun and met his brother while returning to his father-in-law's house. Taft is said to have fired the shotgun once, killing his brother instantly.

Officers arrested both Western and Dillard Murphy, who allegedly shot 2 men (Garrett and Marchbanks).

Definitions: Mulatto, which is half black and half white, but used more generally with black people whose partial white ancestry shows.

They used to have exact definitions of racial heritage, back when laws specified which race could do what;

Mulatto = 1/2 black, 1/2 white

Quadroon = 1/4 black, 3/4 white

Octroon = 1/8 black, 7/8 white

In some states "one drop" of black ancestry meant you had to sit in the back of the bus and couldn't marry a white person. In others, if you were 1/16th or less black, you could do all the things white people could.

I have seen people of mixed ancestry switch between mulatto and white, or mulatto and black, on successive censuses.

The definition of race changed between censuses. To understand what it should have meant for your specific census year, you need to find out what the enumerators (the people who took the census) were told as to the definitions. Those instructions for each federal census year can be found at:

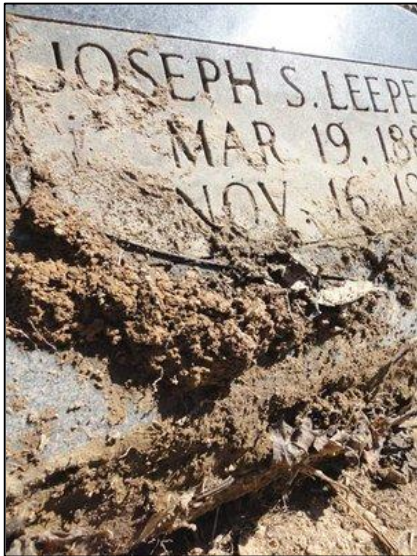
LEFT IN NEGLECT: VOLUNTEERS WORK TO CLEAN OLD CEMETERY

COOKEVILLE -- Volunteers chopped down trees, pulled weeds and dusted off dirty graves, all part of an effort that kick-started last week to clean up an old black cemetery that has been long left in a state of neglect.



Glenn Jones, Putnam County archivist, walked through the grounds on Thursday, brushed away limbs covering several headstones, and even planted a makeshift marker at the foot of one of the graves, unmarked and sunken in. He organized several other volunteers who joined in on the bright and sunny afternoon.

"This is the worse cemetery I've been to," Jones said, looking around. "There are graves everywhere."

The all African-American cemetery fronts a street Jones says is part of Buck Avenue, a graveled, unpaved thoroughfare that unassumingly juts out from West Ninth Street, not far from the intersection of North Willow Avenue and a series of Tennessee Tech Village apartments. There's not even a sign to mark its passage.

"I didn't even know there was a cemetery here until a few years back," said Putnam County Executive Kim Blaylock, who came out to see the work being done. "This is almost overwhelming to look at. It makes me so sad."

Small saplings, dead leaves and weeds have overpowered many of the graves. Although some do have newer stones, there are others with toppled headpieces, and some are designated by simple funeral markers, tiled letters missing that once spelled out the names of the deceased. The only way to distinguish many graves is by patches of sunken ground.

"We don't know how many people are buried here," Jones said. "One guy said around 300. There are 12 veterans, at least."

Randy Williams, historic preservation planner with the Upper Cumberland Development District, said the cemetery in question has always been called the "black Buck" cemetery, which distinguished it from a

handful of other Buck cemeteries in the county. Jones said he'd like to rename it Cookeville Buck Cemetery so it still stands alone.

The Buck family was very prominent in the settlement of this area, and the Bucks were slave holders in the antebellum period, Williams said. Many, if not all, the Buck slaves took the family surname as their own.

"Some of the former Buck slaves were probably the first to be buried in the cemetery," Williams said. But no one knows exactly how many graves are there, he said.

"We'd have to do a ground-penetrating radar study and some archaeological testing to know for sure, and even then it would be difficult to ascertain beyond doubt," Williams continued. "Through the years, the Buck descendants and other members of the local black community were buried in the cemetery."

Bobby Farley has family members buried there -- his mother, father, aunts, cousins. He said the last clean-up effort took place more than two decades ago. Besides some mowing, little else has been done since.

"We had a big day over here about 20-25 years ago, we had food and everything. It was all cleaned out, and they really did an excellent job," Farley said. "And then, after that, it just started going down, down, down."

"It seems like everybody's lost interest," said Evelyn Buck, nodding toward a site where he mother-in-law is buried nearby. "It's just neglect. Nobody has taken it upon themselves to do it."

Archives effort

Jones is in the process of making a file for every Putnam County cemetery -- according to other researchers, there are more than 500 sites here, he said -- information that would include a list of those buried, a land survey and copy of the deed.

To get a complete cemetery profile for the archives, he is also asking family members to submit pictures of their ancestors, an effort that is being kick-started by the Cookeville Buck Cemetery project.

"We need citizens who have family or friends buried there to come out, bring names and information and pictures of anyone buried there," Jones said. "This is a large cemetery with many needs."

He is employing the help of Betty Stark, who has worked at the archives since its beginning in 2008, for the project. On Thursday, holding two L-shaped rods, she used a technique called dowsing to locate gravesites. Stark has a lot of knowledge about area cemeteries and has published eight cemetery books, Jones said.

"I remember the first time I met Miss Betty. We were at a historical society field trip on the square in downtown Gainesboro," Jones said. "Betty was the honored guest, and she demonstrated her skill in locating the deceased in an old graveyard. It was an unforgettable experience. We are lucky to have her assist in this monumental project."

The clean up effort, meanwhile, will continue on a weekly basis and could take months to complete -- help is needed and volunteers with chainsaws are especially in demand. Jones said they plan on adding bare cement blockcaps at each unmarked grave end to signify a resting place. Those caps will later be painted white, Jones said, and sunken graves will be filled with dirt.

"This cemetery has so many veterans and so many people, it has to be fixed," Jones said. "A lot of the people who were buried here were poor and didn't have the means to get a tombstone, and we need help from the community to fix that."

**STUDENTS VOLUNTEER TO

COOKEVILLE — This week U.S.

History students from Tennessee Tech and Nashville State Community College continued the work began last year in cleaning up a cemetery that had been nearly forgotten for years. Located off of West Ninth Street in Cookeville, Cookeville Buck Cemetery was originally called “Black Buck Cemetery” because it was set apart specifically for African Americans in a time when they were not allowed to be buried in the other cemeteries with white residents.

“It’s experiential history,” said Carolyn Powell, a teacher who is coordinating the volunteer efforts. “In other words, this is really contributing to their knowledge of not just history in general, but it gives them hands-on and it allows them to actually apply some of their knowledge in respecting history.”



The graveyard was discovered overgrown with tall grass, brambles and saplings, with many of the tombstones and the graves themselves sunk down into the earth, making tripping hazards at every turn.

“The sandstone (on the gravestones) is such that if it’s tipping in such a way that the rain is hitting it, we lose any of the writing on there,” Powell said. “So I did this gravestone workshop so I know how to properly reset them, how to clean them without damaging them, and so we have crews that are out there cleaning carefully, and in the back they are resetting them so they are perpendicular, also trying to lift them so they’re not as much of a tripping hazard.”

Many of the graves do not even have gravestones, but patchy burial records show that in addition to slaves and, later, citizens, there is a Spanish American War veteran, World War II veterans and Korean War veterans with no monuments buried there. The land was originally owned by settlers from the Buck family,

and the family's slaves were most likely the very first African Americans to be buried on the land.

The volunteers hope to have the whole cemetery cleaned up soon, but are still in need of some help — specifically, someone with a small bulldozer to help remove tree stumps and a group to volunteer to help take regular care of the cemetery. The Putnam County Archives is also working to try to collect as much information on the cemetery as possible. Anyone with information or photos of people who were buried in Cookeville Buck Cemetery, or those interested in donating to help purchase small tombstones for the unmarked graves, can contact the office at 520-0042.

"I'm glad these people are able to come here and volunteer their time for this project," said County Executive Kim Blaylock, who visited the site this week to see the students' progress. "It's sad to think there's a cemetery here in the middle of the City of Cookeville and nobody even knew it was here."

BUCK CEMETERY NEEDS VOLUNTEERS FOR UPKEEP

COOKEVILLE – The Cookeville Buck Cemetery was once in danger of being lost among the underbrush, however over the years, hundreds of volunteers from Tennessee Tech, the Cookeville campus of Nashville State Community College, probation services and area business have pitched in to help clean up.

They've cut grass, straightened headstones and filled in some of the sunken graves. Various landscaping services have donated some dirt, Harris Monuments installed a sign out front, Vaughn's Monuments



donated the use of equipment to help straighten leaning tombstones and Lowe's has donated concrete markers to help mark some of the graves. However even though the four acres is looking better, it still needs some help.

"We've got probably half in pretty good shape, but we are needing more dirt," said Putnam County Archivist Glenn Jones, who has been organizing

the clean-up. "If anyone has dirt, they can dump it by the front entrance, right off the road, and students can wheelbarrow it to put more dirt into the graves that have sunk."

The cemetery, located on 9th Street a half mile west of Willow Avenue, could also use some bulldozer work and stump grinding, groups to help with seasonal mowing, as well as people to help pay for the \$10 granite monuments for the 250 known people buried in the cemetery.

"Originally the history book done by Maurine (Ensor) Patton, past historian, listed just 64 people. Now we know 250," Jones said.

The new names were added after historians realized that the cemetery was formerly known as Old Bushtown Cemetery before being called Black Buck Cemetery. It's a spot important to history of the Cookeville area. Before about 1986, it was an unspoken rule that African Americans who passed away in the Putnam County area were expected to be buried in this particular cemetery instead of with the rest of the community.

Aside from that, very little about the history of the graveyard is known, aside from that it currently belongs to the Buck family.

It was Evelyn Buck and the now late Bobby Farley who Putnam County Archives staff contacted to ask if they wanted assistance in the upkeep.

"I think it's very important that a cemetery, especially one that's right in town, that it's cleaned and kept up, because these people buried here are part of the history of our county and in the City of Cookeville," Jones said.

BUCK CEMETERY'S 'INVISIBLE GRAVES' RESTORED

In the few months since the Cookeville City Council agreed to care for Buck Cemetery, the historic graveyard has changed quite a bit.

Since September, city employees have plowed the middle of the cemetery, grounded tree stumps, leveled the ground and sowed it. Now grass is starting to grow there.

“I’m pleased with the continued progress of Buck Cemetery, and I’m very happy with the city of Cookeville stepping in and doing such a wonderful job,” Putnam County Archivist Glenn Jones said.

“People have no idea we’re working like this.”

Putnam County Executive Randy Porter visited the site last week and was impressed with the work that’s taken place there.

“This looks better than it’s ever looked,” Porter said. “It will be nice when all the grass comes in.”

Last week, two days before Christmas, community service volunteers placed a military headstone for U.S. Army Cpl. James Oliver Hill, who was killed in service on Dec. 2, 1952, at the age of 25.

“That’s the 13th veterans stone we ordered,” Jones said. “In our quest, we decided the veterans needed a veterans’ marker.

“He’s not included on the Putnam County Veterans Wall,” Jones said. “That’s why we wanted to honor him.”

U.S. Congressman Diane Black of Tennessee’s 6th District assisted Jones in getting the marker.

Hill’s headstone is placed alongside that of his father, Andrew Hill, a U.S. Army veteran of World War I.

Jones explained that when the county archives first became involved in rehabilitating the cemetery, former Putnam County historian, the late Maurine Patton, had listed 67 people buried at the Buck Cemetery on 9th Street.

But Carol Bradford, who works in the county archives, uncovered death certificates for over 250 people buried there.

Many of those graves weren’t visible until the city’s recent efforts to uncover the overgrowth there. And even after that, the natural weathering of the gravesites over time has caused many to sink.

Jones and his volunteers have placed cement blocks on known grave sites alongside the metal plates provided by the funeral home and are gradually purchasing small stones for \$10 each that are expected to last longer.

“We need at least 90 more stones,” said Jones, who noted the importance of preserving the cemetery. “A cemetery is not always honoring what’s in the casket, it’s remembering the person, to honor the person.”

Bradford said, “It says you lived, and you are important.”

Several other veterans are buried in Buck Cemetery, and so far, stones have been placed for Fred D. Western, 1925-1962, Air Force, WWII; Alexander (Alex) Farley, 1894-1981, Army, WWI; James H. Click, 1929-1965, Army, Korean War; Herman Lee Jones, 1933-1954, Army, Korean War; Melvin Douglas Hardy, 1930-1983, Army, Korean War; James H. Ware, 1920-1978, Army, WWII; and Thomas Hershel Eldridge, 1918-1966, Army, WWII.

In addition to seeking donations to preserve the Buck Cemetery, Jones wants to encourage people with knowledge of any of the county’s cemeteries to share that information with the archives. “We have a file on every cemetery in the county,” he said.
