Civil War Veteran....Enlisted 9/1/62 in Cookeville.... Horse \$130, equipment \$15.... Present on 12/31/64 muster....

Born 12/22/1831... died 3/22/1914.... William married Susan Caroline Lafayette Goodwin.

William is buried in Cooper Cemetery near Brotherton....

William is the brother to Nathan and Gabriel....

Pension #5325 filed 7/29/1903 from Putnam Co. accepted....

William states he was born in Putnam Co. in 1830.... States he was wounded in action at Franklin Tenn.

and incapacitated from injury (hearing loss).... Took the oath in 1864 rather than go to prison....

William had a wife and five children.... C.J. Davis vouched for his military record.... File indicates he died 3/20/1914....

He was the brother of Marion G.... Widow's pension #5641 filed 10/17/1914 from Putnam Co. accepted....

She was born S. Caroline L. Goodwin on 5/3/1848.... A W.K. Cooper is buried in the Cooper Cemetery in Putnam Co., 12/22/1831 - 3/22/1914.
