John Boyd was a veteran of the 1812 War under Capt. John Sutton's Company of Tennessee Militia and fought at New Orleans under General Andrew Jackson.

Prof. John Jefferson Boyd, 85, died Saturday morning at his home in Rock Springs Valley in the 11th district of this country, following an extended illness. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 at the Pleasant Gove Methodist Church near Gentry of which he was a member with the Rev. David Hailey officiating. Burial was in the Boyd Cemetery in Rock Springs Valley.

Prof. Boyd died on the same farm on which he was born and reared. He was a son of the late Jefferson W. Boyd and Mary Jared Boyd and was the last surviving member of the family. Two of his brothers, the late Alvin W. and Houston S. Boyd were prominent lawyers of the Cookeville bar. Another brother Dr. W. M. Boyd of Madison died a few years ago.

In his young manhood Mr. Boyd was co-principal of the old Cookeville Collegiate Institute afterwards serving 14 years as principal of the Gentry High School near his home.

He served 36 years as justice of the peace from the 11th district. For the past several years he had been an invalid suffering with neuritis.

She lived and died in the house in which she was born and in which her father was born and died.

She had been a devoted member of the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church near her home.

She is survived by two brothers, Esq. John J Boyd of this county and Dr. W. M. Boyd of Jackson County. Two other brothers, the late Alvin W. Boyd and Houston S. Boyd, both of whom were well known attorneys of the Cookeville Bar, each died several years ago.

Funeral services were conducted Friday at the Boyd Family graveyard in Rock Springs Valley.

BOYD, MARY: Mrs. Mary Boyd, widow of Jefferson Boyd, and one of the oldest and most highly esteemed ladies of this county, died on the night of Oct. 22, 1907, at her home in the Eleventh district, of paralysis. She was 83 years old and had been a devoted member of the Southern Methodist church for 75 years, and was greatly beloved by all who knew her. Her remains were interred Wednesday afternoon in the Boyd graveyard in Rock Spring valley, her funeral begin attended by a large number of relatives and friends. She leaves four children, A. W. Boyd of this city, Dr. W. M. Boyd of Jackson county, Prof. J. J. Boyd and Miss Malinda Boyd of Gentry. She was an aunt of P. Y. Jared, Mrs. J. W. Puckett, O. K. Holladay, and H. M. Even A Yankee general knew not to mess with a woman who knew God personally. By Dale Welch, Putnam County historian.

Elizabeth Leath Boyd was a praying woman. Strong in faith, she put wheels under those prayers and God honored them.

Mrs. Boyd was born on Aug. 29, 1785, in Virginia, to Ephraim and Nancy Jones Leath. She married John Boyd, eight years her senior, in Anderson County, TN, on Dec. 16, 1801. The couple moved to the Rock Springs Valley, in what is now the western part of Putnam County.

The Boyd's built a two-story log house that was weather boarded with handmade lumber all through the house. It was there that they raised seven boys and seven girls.

John joined Capt. John Sutton's Company, of Tennessee Militia, during the War of 1812 and fought alongside Gen. Andrew Jackson all the way to New Orleans. After his discharge, Boyd returned to Elizabeth and their children. John died when he was 60 years old. Elizabeth lived for 45 years more, dying at age 97.

Elizabeth was the prayer warrior of the family. It was said that she devoted every Friday to prayer and fasting. She was an active member of the Pleasant Grove Church for over 80 years.

When the Civil War broke out, she had sons and grandsons join the Confederate Army. Some of them were wounded and some died of disease. When friends, neighbors and family needed her help, she was quick to respond. When people had trouble with

Yankees taking everything or one of their sons taken prisoner, she was on the spot. Mrs. Boyd, age 76 at the start of the war, made several trips to Carthage, where Union Col. William B. Stokes, of the 5th Tennessee Cavalry, had his headquarters at the time. Stokes had been a U.S. congressman before the war (and after). She was his cousin and wouldn't take no for an answer. She nearly always got what she wanted. Stokes knew his battles were on the battlefield and not with a relative who was a personal friend of God.

Mary Elizabeth Leath Boyd died in 1882 and is buried in an unmarked grave at the John Boyd Cemetery. From family to Yankee colonels, the lesson learned is to never mess with a praying mother.

After the War Between the States, she applied for a military pension based on the service of John Boyd in the War of 1812. One of the questions on that application asked (and I'm paraphrasing because I don't have it at my fingertips) whether she or her family had supported the effort of the Confederacy—which she most certainly had. She replied "No," apparently realizing that it would affect her pension status. A smart woman, she was granted a pension on John Boyd's service. Posted by James Turner.
