Roe Huddleston’s Death Occurs Friday at His Home Near Gentry.

Isaac Monroe Huddleston was born October 1, 1858 and died July 3, 1936 at his home near Gentry, at the age of seventy seven years and nine months. He joined the M. E. Church at the Old Pleasant Grove at the age of fifteen years and had lived a devoted Christian life since.

He was married to Virginia Frances Robinson, September 19, 1930 and to this union eight children were born, four of whom survive him, O. D. Huddleston, Mamie Huddleston, Jane Huddleston and Adavil Huddleston.

His death though not unexpected, brought sorrow and grief to the hearts of his many friends and relatives for he was a life long resident of the Gentry community and was fondly known as “Uncle Roe” by old and young.

He lived a life of simple honesty, which should be an example for those who follow him.

Funeral serves were conducted Friday afternoon at Pleasant Grove by the Rev. E. M. Wilcox followed by burial at the Uncle Frank Huddleston graveyard.

Archibald Scruggs Jared was killed by a stray bullet while sitting under a tree reading the Bible during the Civil War. A large cedar tree that he set out at his home place near Gentry, TN was cut down in the spring of 1965. It had stood for more than 125 years. A small box made from the wood of this tree is in the possession of Maurine Ensor Patton and also Bert Jared (Egbert). Robert Ensor made both boxes.

Archibald Scruggs Jared was a confederate soldier, mustered 5 December 1862 at Murfreesboro, TN for three years. He was wounded and sent to hospital in Macon GA where he died from the wounds received when shot by a stray bullet while sitting under a tree reading the Bible. Private A. S. Jared 28th Regt., TN Infantry (Later known as Co K). His name appears on the hospital list as being admitted 9 August 1864. He died 7 October 1864. While still in the hospital his brother John and William James Jared were still fighting in the Civil War.
