Diphtheria, also membranous angina. An acute infectious disease characterize by inflammation and the formation of a thick covering on the mucous membranes of the throat and nose. General symptoms included fever, weakness of the heart, and rapidly developing anemia, later understood to be caused by poisons given off from the bacteria responsible for the initiation of the disease. Severe epidemics were reported in different parts of Europe during the 16th, 17th, and 18th centuries. It was a disease of childhood and very fatal. Outbreaks continued throughout the world until the middle of the 20th century.

frequently occurred within three to five days. It was common among the poor and hand fed infants, and was found frequently in summer and early autumn.

Tuberculosis, also the great white scourge, white plague. An infectious disease characterized by small growths, called tubercles, that firmly embed themselves in tissues. The tubercles grow rapidly and die, thus destroying the surrounding tissues and resulting in cavities in the area of the body where they were located. Any part of the body could be affected and the symptoms would vary with the locality of the disease. Signs and symptoms common to all forms were loss of strength, anemia, fever, sweats, and emaciation. Person to person transmission of the disease was common as well as through drinking contaminated cow's milk. In the late 1800's and early 1900's, it was considered the most wide spread of human infections, and until the 1880's it was regarded as a constitutional disease.

Influenza, also epidemic catarrh, grip, la grippe, lightning catarrh. An acute, infectious disease that attacks one of three systems: respiratory, gastrointestinal, or nervous. It is characterized by fever, inflammation of mucous membranes with discharge, pain in muscles, and rapid exhaustion. The most common complications in the 19th and early 20th centuries were pneumonia and, occasionally, insanity.
