Pvt. Sam Jared, son of Mr. and Mrs. Bob Jared, of Boma, and a nephew of Mrs. Ralph Wirt of Cookeville, arrived home today after serving for the past 11 months in the European Theater of War, attached to the 95<sup>th</sup> Division of Patton's Third Army. Pfc. Jared landed in Boston, MA, on Sunday, and following a brief stay at Camp Atterbury, IN, is now at home for a 30-day furlough before reassignment for the Pacific area.

After a training period at Indiantown Gap, Pa, Pfc. Jared, who has been in service that past 17 months left for overseas duty in August of last year and landed in France. Sent immediately to the front lines, he was

in combat duty at the battles of the Ruhr, the Rhine and Saar Rivers and was in Germany interior on V-E Day. When ordered home he was stationed in Offen, Germany. He wears the ETO Ribbon with three stars, and came through the various campaigns without being wounded.
