Jackson Co., TN, 10th Civil Dist.. Size 6.6 acre. From Gainesboro take Hwy. 56 toward Baxter, Putnam Co., TN. Turn right on Flynn's Creek Road. Cemetery will be on your right just after passing the Flatt & Dyer Road. A lot of obituaries call this the Fox Cemetery, located in Jackson Co., TN. A sign is up RASH CEMETERY.

Biographical Sketch of John W. Fox

John William Fox, son of the late Frank P. and Sarah Fox, was born September 30, 1872, in Jackson County, Tenn., near Gainesboro. He was of a family of eight sons and one daughter. Receiving such education as was offered by the rural schools of his county, he then went to the college located at Bloomington Springs in Putnam County. He taught school for thirteen years. The free-school terms were then very short, but he would carry on during the winter months by subscription.

On December 1, 1895, he was married to Celina C. Montgomery. Miss Montgomery was of a very fine family and has made for Brother Fox a wife that has really and truly proved to be a helpmeet for him in every sense of the word. Of this union, five children have been reared to adulthood. Two sons—Robert, who is now the agricultural teacher at the Central High School in Gainesboro, and who devotes most every Sunday to preaching the gospel; and Frank, who is assistant cashier of the Jackson County Bank of Gainesboro. The three daughters—Mrs. Jordan West, Mrs. Eugene Chaffin and Mrs. Ernest Hestand, are all mothers and keepers of the home. The children have all been members of the church of Christ from a very early age.

Shortly after his marriage, his parents moved to another farm, leaving Brother Fox to live where he was born and reared. He still lives at this place. He has spent his life on the farm and has been one of the hardest workers among men. While having been a success in truck farming and raising live stock, he has in addition to his regular farm work cut and marketed the timber from his large plantation. He engaged in the hauling of logs, lumber, cross-ties, telephone poles, and any other work that was needed. With all of the above work mentioned, he found time to serve his county as member of the Board of Education, of which he was chairman for seven years. He also served as trustee of his county for eight years. I speak to his credit, no one ever kept better records of the county's finances, nor ever conducted himself in a more commendable manner than did Brother Fox as an officer.

In 1897, he obeyed the gospel under the preaching of the late J. P. Watson. Three years later, at the suggestion of E. L. Jackson, he preached his first sermon on the subject of the "Parables". Two confessed their faith in Christ and were baptized as a result of this sermon. From that time to the present, he has been faithful to the Lord in preaching and in every other phase of church work. He has conducted more funerals than any man now living within his county. The weather was never too cold nor roads too bad for him to ride horseback several miles to assist in funerals. Many times he would have two funerals several miles apart, thus taking the entire day. No record has been kept as to the number of funerals and similar

work done during these forty years, but they have been many. During epidemics and times when many deaths were occurring, he was always kept busy. For none of these services did I ever know of him taking a penny for service rendered. In addition to work donated to such causes, he has been one of the most charitable men in the county. No one can ever know or imagine the amount of money, corn, meat, lard, and other things that he has freely given in helping those in need. The Lord blessed him in abundance of the material things, and Brother Fox has freely used them in doing good. He has been successful in his work as a preacher, baptizing hundreds of people and helping in the establishing of new congregations. He has done extensive work in visiting the sick and has baptized many people who were sick. Their condition was often such that they could not go to the creek, he would then use a bathtub, scalding pan, wagon bed, or box in order to bury them in baptism as taught in the New Testament.

Brother Fox is still very active for a man of his age. He and his brother Russ Fox are elders of the Antioch congregation where they worship. He is appreciated, respected, and loved by the people who know him.

The above things are only a few of the commendable traits and deeds that might be listed to the credit of this good man and his work. I am glad of the opportunity to speak this tribute of truth to the honor of this man while he yet lives; I am glad to have known him and had the benefit of his fatherly advice and Christian life. May God spare him many years yet and give us many more like him.
