He was stationed on a shipping ship that was headed for the U.S.A. with a load of goods. The ship arrived in U.S.A. waters the same time that Pearl Harbor was being invaded by the Japanese. The ship was told to turn around and go home. On route back to Japan the ship was bombed and it sunk, killing Akira Kurokawa. He was named "Timothy" after his father Ronald Timothy Denny.

Grant Ronald Teiji Denny was named after his great-grandfather Teiji Habu. He was named "Ronald" after his father Ronald Timothy Denny.

Reed & Grant call their grandparents – Ojiichan which means grandfather and Obaachan which means grandmother. The "O" in the words meaning honorary.

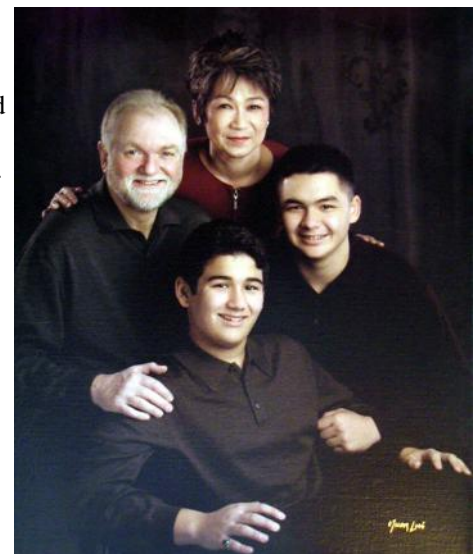

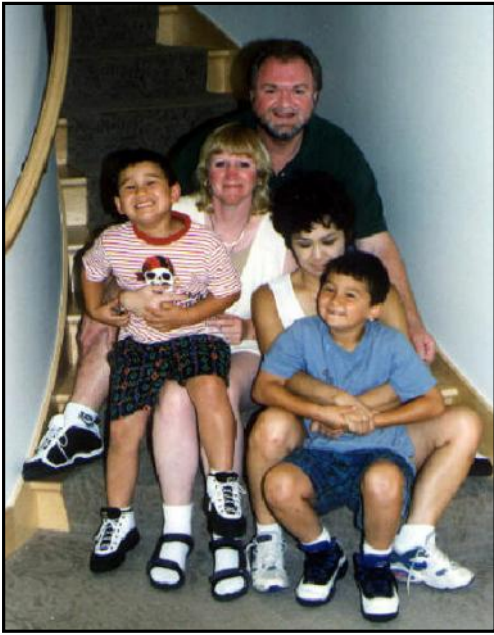

Fumi was born in Hiroshima, Japan on April 4, 1924 to Shunzo and Riu Kurokawa and raised on her family farm in Selma, California. She was Selma High's newspaper editor and valedictorian of her class, but unable to attend graduation as she and her family were evacuated to Arizona under Executive Order 9066 during WWII. Fumi left the Gila River internment camp to study at the Vogue College of Design in Chicago, where she met Yutaka Jack Habu. He brought her to his hometown, Seattle, where she devoted her life to her husband, children and supporting the family businesses. Fumi was elegant, thoughtful, kind-hearted, hard-working and took pride and care in everything she endeavored. She had an adventurous spirit; a passion for learning; many hobbies, which included her plants, garden and sewing; and was a fabulous cook and the perfect mother and obaachan. Fumi and Jack enjoyed many years of golf and travel together and celebrated their 71st wedding anniversary last June 23.
